

Washington Irving

Washington Irving (1783—1859) was one of the first American writers. He was born in New York City and studied law there. From 1815 until 1832 he lived in Europe, and while he was there he published most of his successful stories, including *The Legend of Sleepy Hollow* and *Rip Van Winkle* (1819). On his return to the USA he travelled west into Indian territory, a journey he described in *A Tour of the Prairies* (1835).

华盛顿·欧文

华盛顿·欧文(1783—1859)是美国最早的作家之一。他生于纽约并在那里学习法律。1815年至1832年,他旅居欧洲,在此期间发表了自己最成功的几部作品,其中包括《睡谷的传说》和《瑞普·凡·温克尔》(1819)。华盛顿·欧文回到美国后,曾到西部的印第安准州进行考察,并在《大草原之旅》(1835)中描述了这段旅程。






