前言

《高中英语听力(高三)》是根据目前高考的要求以及学生的实际需求编写的。

听力训练是英语复习备考中的重要一环。纵观近几年的高考试题,我们不难看出听力部分的要求在不断提高。从大多数考生的现状分析来看,听力仍是比较薄弱的环节之一,这里既有课堂上听力训练不足的原因,也可能有课后过多注重书面练习而忽视听力训练的原因。因而为了弥补这种不足,有必要在最后的备考阶段强化这方面的训练。本书提供的听力材料内容涉及新闻、科技、生活、体育、故事等,选编的材料贴近现实生活,题材广泛,语言地道,难度适中。书中的试题难度及题型都符合高考要求,供学习者在实践中迅速提高听力能力,通过这些训练可以帮助考生在原有基础上进一步提高听力水平,在考试中取得良好成绩,以提高英语的总体水平。
