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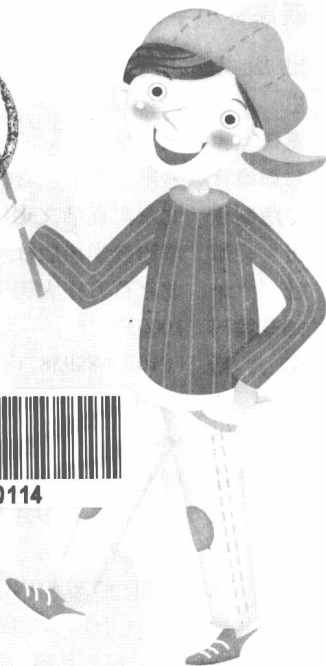
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前 言

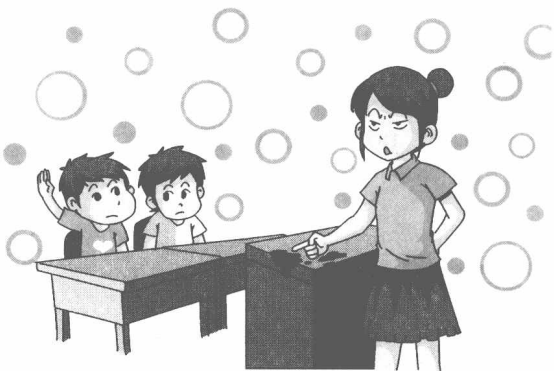
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I Can Go Home Now

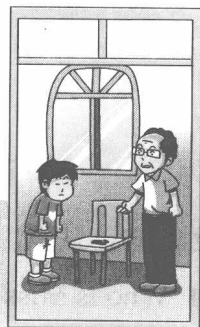
Who Pours Ink on My Chair?
