



## 序言

編者在受教育的過程中,常覺國內的英語教育,欠缺一套好的會話 教材。根據我們最近所做的研究顯示,各級學校的英語老師與關心的讀 者也都深深覺得,我們用的進口會話教材,版面密密麻麻,不但引不起 學習興趣,所學又不盡與實際生活相關。像一般會話書上所教的早餐, 總是教外國人吃的 cereal (麥片粥),而完全沒有提及中國人早餐吃的 稀飯(香港餐館一般翻成"congee",美國人叫它"rice soup")、 豆漿(soy bean milk)、燒餅(baked roll)、油條(Chinese fritter)該如何適切地表達?

我們有感於一套好的教材必須能夠真正引發學生的興趣,內容要切合此時此地(here and now)及讀者確實的需求,也就是要本土化、具體化。

兩年多來,在這種共識之下,我們全體編輯群東持專業化的精神,實地蒐集、調查日常生活中天天用得到、聽得到的會話,加以歸類、整理,並設計生動有趣的教學活動,彙編成。AMERICAN TALKS"這套最適合中國人的英語會話報材。




