

# 前這

英语课在小学阶段的教学和考试中的地位越来越重要。"英语课程标准"要求小学阶段学生必须完成10万字以上的英语阅读量,阅读技能测试也是各类英语考试的重中之重。因此,为了配合英语课堂教学和满足学生阅读技能训练的需求,我们特组织了一批来自一线的优秀教师,组成了"广外小学英语新课程研究组",倾力打造一批小学英语辅导书。

本书特色:

1. 编写目标明确。

本书以培养学生学习英语的兴趣为首要目标。通过阅读训练和测试,引导学生形成良好的阅读习惯,掌握各种阅读技巧,拓展知识面,轻松达到学习目标。

2. 选材新颖、生动,功能实用。

本书的阅读短文选材遵循本地区教材及课堂教学特点,题材 全面、难易度适中、可读性强,体裁以应用文和记叙文为主,故 事生动有趣,而且还附有精美的译文,便于学生对照自学提高。

3. 题型多样,设计科学。

本书题型活泼、多样化,囊括了小学升初中考试阅读题的常 考题型,将词汇、短语、语法等考点巧妙地融入试题中,引导学 生在读中学、读中记、读中练。

在小学高年级的阅读训练中,部分练习的难度达到初中二年级的水平,为小学升初中的择校测试做好准备。

#### 本书使用建议:

- 1. 全书设计了 100 篇阅读训练,建议同学们周一至周五每天训练 1 篇,这样的学习既轻松又有效。
- 2. 建议同学们要将快速阅读与仔细研读相结合,这样有利于阅读能力的快速提高。
  - 3. 建议大声朗读每一篇短文,这样有利于语感的快速积累。
- 4. 对于阅读过程中遇到的生词,不要急于查字典、看注释,可以先根据上下文猜测,锻炼自己的猜词能力。但过后一定要将这些生词记录下来,及时地学习、巩固,这样可以快速地扩大词汇量。
- 5. 每篇短文后的译文仅供参考,可以根据译文试着用自己的语言复述一下短文的大意,这样,口语和书面表达的能力也将同时得到快速提高。

学英语就像烧开水,要一鼓作气,不能烧一把,停一阵再去烧。否则,水永远烧不开,至多成为温水。因此,我们要持之以恒,学到沸腾,消灭夹生,才能突破高分!

## Shenzhen's Pavilion



Bradley has served four American presidents, and many world leaders over his 23-year cooking work. He was also a head chef at the



They will prepare 30 tons of rice and 60 tons of meat during the November 12—27 Asia Games. One million bananas will be eaten during the Games.

"Of course (athletes) like to eat all kinds of fruits, they also like pizza and Italian pasta. Young people all over the world like to eat this," Bradley told the Huashang Daily.

Asian Games covered 21 cities in Guangdong Province. They


