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写在前面的话

为了帮助广大考生进一步了解PETS,有效地备考和实践,我们严格按照教育部 考试中心制定的《全国英语等级考试考试大纲(全新版)》,编写了《全国英语等 级考试考前冲刺》。

本套丛书针对PETS一至五级(包括一级的附属级一级B)考试,分别编写成册。

一、全国英语等级考试概述

全国英语等级考试 (Public English Test System, 简称PETS), 是教育部考试中心设计并组织的全国性英语水平考试体系。PETS共设五个考试级别, 以英语的应用和交际能力测试为主, 根据国际外语教学界通行的交际语言活动模式, 对语言的运用能力进行了分类和定义。在试卷结构上, 根据不同层次的需要, 设置了考查听、说、读、写各种技能的题型, 确保各级别都能全面考查考生的交际能力。

二、证书效用

笔试和口试均合格者,由教育部考试中心颁发《全国英语等级考试合格证书》。该证书既可作为持有者英语能力水平的权威性证明,又可为各地各单位对其 所用人才的英语水平提供一个公正、统一的评价尺度。

三、PETS第三级考试试题结构

试题分笔试和口试两部分,其中笔试内容包括听力、英语知识运用、阅读理解、写作和口语。

四、PETS第三级标准

PETS第三级是PETS五个级别中的中间级。通过该级考试的考生,其英语水平相当于我国普通高中毕业后在大专院校又学习了2年公共英语或自学了同等程度英语课程的水平。同时也基本符合诸如企事业单位的行政秘书、经理助理、一般管理人员或科技工作者、外企职员等以及同层次其他工作在对外交往中的基本需要。该级考生应能在大多数日常的工作和社会生活的情景中,可以用英语和外国人交流,不仅交流具体信息,也可以交流思想和观点。能适当运用基本的语法知识,掌握4000

左右的词汇以及相关词组,还可以写工作备忘录、信函、通知和便条等。

五、编写特色

1. 模块设计,分门别类

本书采用模块化设计,共分听力、英语知识运用、阅读理解、写作和口语等5大模块,每个模块又有7套模拟练习题,而后集中整合,并配有3套综合模拟题,供考生自练、自学、自测、自检,旨在使考生能知彼知己、成竹在胸:

2. 针对性强,有的放矢

编写过程中,无论单项练习还是综合模拟题,编者都力求使其难度相等、篇幅相当、内容相近、题材相似,达到"实战"之目的;

3. 提供解析, 以明得失

为方便考生自学,并使考生深入了解做题中的得失对错,本书还提供了 试题答案及详解。解析部分力求抓住要点,通俗易懂、简洁实用,使考生能 学有所得。

本书由北京大学英语博士、北京师范大学教授张政担任总主编,参编人员由全国英语等级考试三级考官张焕香、李从容参加编写。由于时间仓促及编者水平所限,难免挂一漏万,恳请广大专家、教师和使用者不吝指正。

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第一章 听力模块



听力备考概述

考题结构

该部分由A、B两节组成,考查考生理解英语口语的能力。

A节:共10题。分别为10段简短对话。要求考生能从对话双方(一般为男女双方)中,了解简单的对话信息,掌握对话中提及的事实性信息,并能做出简单的逻辑推理。

B节:共15题。包括3段对话和1段独白,内容多为讲话、访谈、讲座、新闻报道等。一般题目的设计为:第一段对话,设3题;第二、三段对话设4题;第四段独白设4题。题目考点按照录音材料次序排列,题目难度也依次加大。

每段录音材料只播放一遍。问题不在录音中播放,仅在试卷上印出。在考试中,播放录音材料前、后,试题设计者已为考生留出浏览题目和解答题目的时间,并伴有考试提示音。考试提示音是指在正式播放每一考题内容前的提示声音,提醒考生接下来要听的内容和相应的考试题目。在听力部分考试结束前,还会专门留出2分钟的时间,让考生将试卷上的答案转涂到答题卡1上。听力部分开始后所有的考试指示语、停顿以及转涂答案时间都已经录制在考试录音带上。带耳机进行听力测试的考生中途不要摘下耳机,应在最后音乐结束,听到 That is the end of Listening Comprehension 后,摘下耳机。该部分所需时间约为25分钟(含转涂时间)。

考试内容

听力理解能力是与外国人直接交往中必不可少的语言技能之一,也是考试的主要内容之一。该部分要求考生能够听懂社会生活中的以及日常生活中的简短独白或对话。考试大纲中详细列出了考生应该掌握的听力技能,其具体要求如下:

A. 主旨要义 (main idea)

任何一段对话或独白总会围绕一个主旨要义或一个中心思想展开。有时主旨要 义会比较明确,有时则会贯穿整个对话或独白,需要考生自己去归纳、概括。

B. 具体信息 (specific fact)

对话或短语中需要一些具体信息,如人物、时间、地点、事件等。这些信息是 理解和把握主旨要义或进行交流必不可少的内容,也是听力部分的考查重点。

C. 判断推理 (inference)

话语发生的背景和对话者之间的关系对话语的含义有着举足轻重的作用。例如

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"我很想和你一起去看电影,但我晚上要做作业"就是一种委婉的拒绝。因此,根据信息进行推理,作出合理的判断,也是听力测试考查的重点之一。

D. 观点态度 (attitude)

一般来讲,说话者总会有自己的说话意图,或提问,或回答,或阐述自己的观点,或表明自己的态度,或支持赞成,或反对批评,这在很大程度上有助于考生对整个对话的理解。有时,说话者的观点和态度隐含在信息中,需要考生自己去揣摩推测。

应考对策

- A. 熟练掌握并运用考试大纲中所列的功能意念表和语言技能表。在平时的训练中,碰到符合这两个表的内容,有特色的语言表达,就可以把它们记录下来,注意 多积累。同时这样做也是一举两得的事情,可以为后面的口试做好准备。
- B. 培养正确高效的听力训练习惯。第一,要学会合理支配听力考试中的时间。 在正式考试中,考卷发下来后,听力部分开始前后都有相当长的一段时间供考生利 用。考生应该抓紧时间阅读考题,标出考题中需要注意的地方,为考试争取时间, 提高听力的效率。可以在平时的听力训练中进行强化和提高。第二,在平时的听力 训练中,要培养边听边记下要点的习惯。有意识地培养自己的短时记忆能力及对一 些主题的敏感和识别的能力。第三,正确对待录音材料中生词和听不懂的情况。在 平时训练中,录音材料中出现生词和听不懂的情况时,要善于通过上下文信息猜测 或事后补救,切不可纠缠于细节而影响全局。
- C. 平时做个有心人,注意积累听力中的常用句型和习惯表达。训练中,要注重在语境中,提炼文章的主旨大意,提高正确理解听力内容的能力。
- D. 最后特别值得建议的是:每次听力训练时,要注意力高度集中地去听,但一般每次训练的时间不宜超过30分钟。考生在详细了解以上听力能力的标准和培养方法后,循序渐进,持之以恒,就会取得理想的效果。
