把简单的单词用活

笔者从事英语教学已有十余年,见证了众多因为英语而心力交瘁的学习者,他们付出了大量的金钱、时间和精力,然而,依然只能勉强应付考试,表达(说出来、写出来)依然令他们望洋兴叹。

简化英语的先驱之一查尔斯•凯•奥格登(Charles Kay Ogden) 于上世纪20年代设计出了他所谓的「基础英语」(Basic English)。 它只用了850个单词——奥格登表示,对于交流来说,这已经足够了。

而事实上,绝大多数英语学习者的词汇量远远超过了850个,那么,为什么还远不能自如交流(包括书面交流)呢?这个原因并不复杂,就是没有把简单的单词用活。

本书精选300个最简单的单词——这绝对是中学生都会认为 十分简单的单词,但却由这些单词产生出成千上万的生动、地 道的表达。

也许, 你会觉得这是在吹嘘, 那就信手翻两页看看吧!

生难的单词或许考试是要用到的,但在日常的口头或书面表达便用不上,如果生拉硬扯地用那些"大词"反而显得你的英语太正式甚至蹩脚,这就是老外为什么说中国学生说话像写文章。我们也许看过老外写的Email,会发现他们的用词十分的简单,几乎都是我们十分熟悉的词,却把意思表达得清楚明了。

秘诀就在于用好、用活这些简单单词!
