PREFACE

前　　言

這本“日用英文同義字手冊”，彙集了單字近 800 個，分編成 313 組。通過辨義、舉例和註釋，以說明各單字本身的確切意義，以及每組同義字之間意義上和用法上的區別，供學生、自修英語者和教師們參考之用。

英語也和其他許多語言一樣，有着極其豐富的同義字彙。它們的涵義看來差別不大，有些甚至可以互用；但嚴格來說，這些所謂同義字，並不是在多種意義上和用法上完全相同的。在英語中，絕對同義的字是極其少有的，多的是意義近似而又各有其特有的用法，這使學英語的人增加不少困難。例如我們日常慣用的“大小”的“小”字，在英語中就有 little 和 small 兩字，它們的字義雖說相同，但涵義却不一样。比方說：a little child 和 a small child，照字面解，同樣是“一個小孩”。但前者所指的，是包括年齡和個子都小的孩子，且兼有憐愛之意；而後者却僅指身裁比同年齡的小孩子較小罷了。如果我們學英語的時候，對同義字不作深入研究，就難以明白它們的確切涵義；在運用時，自然無法選用最恰當的字眼來表達自己的意思了。同時，研究同義字，對提高閱讀能力也很有幫助，因為一篇好文章，必然用字確切，如果不理解作者為什麼選用這一字而不用另一字，你還不能算是真正讀通了那篇文章。

本書爲了切合實用，所選的同義字，均以日常慣用的爲原則，生僻而古舊的字捨棄不編。爲了便於說明和解釋清楚起見，每個單字之後都附有例句，這些例句都是生活上的日常用語和書寫體例，對會話練習和作文描寫都有所幫助。同時，每個單字之後都註有詞性，以資辨識。至於文法上的特有用法，則在例句之後加以說明。本書正文之前編有組字目錄，是以帶頭字按字序編排；書後有單字索引，以便翻查。

本書所列的同義字，有些是根據中國人學英文的特有困難而選的。比方 *congratulate* 和 *celebrate* 兩字，英美人士並不視爲同義，他們也決不會用錯，但英漢字典上的釋義，兩字都爲“慶祝”、“祝賀”，那就很可能會用錯了。所以凡中國人感到使用困難而意義近似的字，本書也列入論述。

本書所選的字只從日常慣用方面着眼，其他方面的同義字難免有所遺漏，同時限於編者識見，自有許多不當之處，尚望讀者們多多指正。

A

Able, Capable

Able [形]——“有才能的”，“有能力的”，指人的才智而言。強調不但聰明，而且有受過實際鍛煉的才幹。含義較 **capable** 強。

Capable [形]——“有能力的”，“可以做的”，“能勝任的”（有好、壞二義）。

例：Mr. Lee is an *able* young man.

李先生是一位能幹的青年。

This sentence is more than I am *able* to understand it. 這句子我不能明白它的意思。

He is *capable* of anything.

他什麼事都作得出（通常帶有不好的意思）。

She was too tired to be *capable* of more exertions.
她吃力得不能再努力了。

【註】用作敘述形容詞（predicative adjective）時
“able”後接“infinitive”，“capable”後接“of”。

Abolish, Cancel

Abolish [動]——是“廢除”的意思。

Cancel [動]——是“取消”或“使失效力”的意思。

例：In my opinion, such corrupt practices should be *abolished*. 照我的意見，這種陋習應該廢除。

This bad customs has long been *abolished*.

這些壞風俗早已廢除了。

If it rains, let our engagement be *cancelled*.

假使下雨，我們的約會取消吧。

The minister has *cancelled* his leave of absence.

部長已銷假了。
