## 出版說明

學英文没有捷徑,但有訣竅。

多讀、多聽可以增進英文的知識,培養實力;多說、 多寫可以強化學習的效果,了解運用上的困難,使你在聽、 讀時更加警覺、更容易吸收。

没有在聽、說、讀、寫上下過一番工夫而想精通英文 是不可能的事。然而,光是多讀、多聽、多說、多寫,但 方法不對,也不一定能精通英文。就像一個上了年紀,受 過教育的中國人,多讀、多聽、多說、多寫的條件也許都 具備了,不見得就精通中文。其中的關鍵,除了語言的天 賦以外,主要在於方法是否正確。

本書彙集國人說、寫英文常犯的典型錯誤,依錯誤的 形態加以分類整理。先列出中文句子,接著英文正誤並舉, 附以詳細的解說。透過這些錯誤分析,等於爲讀者指出學 習英文道路上的障礙以及迴避之道。讀者若能仔細研讀比 較書中六百多個案例及其分析説明,當能掌握英文的語法 特質,了解中英語法的異同,突破學習英文的瓶頸,表達 英文時就可以更得心應手。

全書共六章,但我們特別著重**中國式英文**這一部分。 由於受到中文詞彙及句法的影響,國人最難以克服的英文 典型錯誤是**中國式英文**,往往乍看之下合乎文法,中國人
