# Preface



“最新雅思考前冲刺模考卷”系列的研发、整理及出版是基于我们长期以来对中国雅思考生人群的观察：首先，几乎每个考生都做过或接触过剑桥雅思的真题，甚至不少人把《剑一》到《剑七》的所有真题都做了一遍；接下来的困境就是找不到其他像样的真题去做，而市面上充斥的不是质量低劣的所谓“真题”，就是打着剑桥旗号的雅思伪书，充其量也只能糊弄少数不明真相又急于求成的考生。

本着拨乱反正的信念和决心，我们感到必须要给广大考生一个交代，即通过推出一系列的高质量试卷，让大家在剑桥雅思真题之外，进一步认识雅思考试的真实情况，并起到去伪存真、以正视听的作用。如果可以用八个字来扼要地给出该系列丛书的一个全貌的话，我想应该是“吸收”、“逼真”、“创新”及“预见”。

在先期的构思阶段，我们参考了大量国外原版书籍中的出题样式和高频话题，把其中适合中国雅思考生的可取之处吸收过来，达到在考题、题型及考试趋势等方面的新、最全、最准确。读者将发现，无论是听力还是阅读，其出题点都直指中国考生的常见弱点，因此可非常有效地矫正其最薄弱的环节。

既然是模考卷，就必须让做题者有一种身临其境的感受，所以我们尽量在试卷的排版设计和文字风格上向剑桥雅思真题靠拢，在官方题库秘不公布且出版物极其有限的现实困境中另辟一个新天地，创造出另一种真实。更为重要的是，我们解决了考生们的困惑，让有志于获取雅思高分者有更多的机会“临阵磨枪”，以更佳的技能水平及心理状态迎接考试。

作为雅思领域的研究者,创新是我们的日常任务,也是我们做每一本书的首要宗旨。例如在口语分册中,除了效仿剑桥雅思口语真题的出题样式(即 Part 1 有 4 道日常生活问题,Part 2 有 1 道描述题,Part 3 有 6 道学术性问题),我们成功研制了每道题目的模拟答案(Model Response),也就是众多考生非常期待的“标准答案”。但是,我们绝不希望这些原创材料成为所谓的“标准答案”,因为一旦如此定位,它们就会沦为被考生死记硬背的对象,而再完美的答案只要是用死记硬背的方式再现出来,得分也会低得可怜!基于以上的考量,我们同样希望读者对这些模拟答案采取一种创新式的看法,即把它们当成答题的某种思路或多种途径之一,不拘泥于其中具体的一字一句,而是去感受回答题目时候的思想起伏,把握整个答案的前后脉路,并领会作者对于该问题的深层见解及可能存在的言外之意。我相信,能这样去做的考生会在雅思口语考场上更有出色的发挥,因为他们已达到思路的内化及整合的境界了。

正如众多考生所期待的那样,我们在整个系列中加入了大量预测的元素,直接反映在听、说、读、写四门考试的最新预测题中:不仅听力和阅读中出现了大量的新话题及少数罕见题型(其罕见性恰好可以证明未来考试的某种趋势),而且我们尝试在写作及口语中沿着剑桥雅思出题者以往的出题思路,给出了相当丰富的符合雅思考试规律的预测题。这些预测题既和一贯的经典话题吻合,又恰当反映出当今的热点时事及全球走势,因此具备了较高的预测命中率。

最后,感谢朗阁教育集团的诸位同仁给予我们一如既往的支持,也感谢上海交通大学出版社的郁金豹先生和易文娟女士为该系列丛书的设计提供了许多宝贵的建议。希望考生在使用过程中能提供尽可能多的修正意见,这样我们就能更好地贯彻上述的八字方针,以增进大家的阅读体验,并提升考生们的技战术水平及备考信心。


