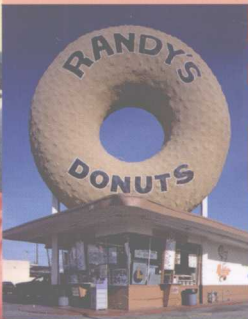

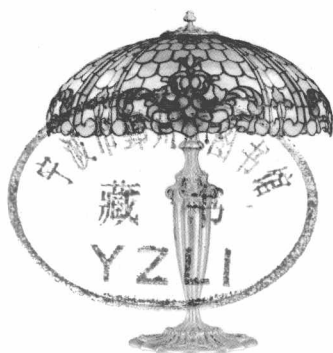

# 序言

## 从多元的角度整理词组

在平日的学习中，很多学生记不住词汇，而词组又占了很大的比例。由于词组，尤其是动词词组的含义比较多，无形中增加了学生记忆的难度。本书旨在通过作者在实际教学中因“生”施教积累的经验，帮助学生克服学好英语的一大障碍。

本书名为“全解”，旨在从不同角度全方位解析高中阶段所应掌握的英语词组，以高考要求掌握的词组为依据通过不同部分的划分，全面整理，帮助学生记忆理解。

全书内容按照不同的逻辑功能共划分三个部分。

### 个个突破必备基础词组。

这一部分词组适合于各种水平的学生使用，只讲解基本意义和用法，配以典型、精彩例句，旨在帮助基础薄弱的学生掌握必备词组，夯实英语学习基础。

### 分组强记关键常考词组。

这一部分词组是高考的重点和常考点。掌握了这些词组，在平日的学习和考试中就可做到游刃有余。本部分词组全部围绕一个核心词分组整理，每个词组除讲解基本意义和用法，还进行了拓展，配以同义、反义、补充等内容，起到扩充知识的作用。同时有些词组意义较多，这些意义是按照高考出现的频率排列的，在使用时，要特别注意前几个意义。

### 归类辨析相关易混词组

这一部分旨在通过词组间的前勾后连，通过同义词组、近义词组、形近词组、同一介词搭配等关系，将不同的词组联系在一起，起到由一及十的效果。



全书配备440道单项选择题，起到综合训练、巩固知识的作用。选择题有高考题，让你体验高考的硝烟；也有模拟题，让你为高考做好准备。此外，全书最后附有词组总索引，有利于学生速查速记词组。

本书对于高考常考的词组进行全面整理，便于高中学生随时翻阅识记，起到备战高考之用。有了本书的帮助，相信你在自己的学习中一定会做到事半功倍的。

本书所选词组包含了老人教课本、新课标、外研、北师大、牛津、重大、冀教等全国使用的各个版本教材上的词组，适合于使用不同版本教材的高中学生使用。
