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
編者序

I'll back her all the way. 我會自始至終支持她的。

all thumbs 笨手笨脚的;笨拙的

I'm all thumbs when it comes to sewing. 說起做女紅,我是非常笨拙的。

all wet.

I'm afraid your idea is all wet. 我想你的想法是不對的。

along for the ride 隨著他人走,看看「不怎麼認真地參與一事」

Don't mind me. I'm just along for the the ride. 别管我,我 只是看看而已。

as is (物品) 照原狀 [不做修理或改進]

The salesman said I could buy the car for \$500 as is, or give him \$1,200 after he fixes all its problems. 售貨員說我可以以 500 元按現在的樣子買這部車,或是給他 1,200 元把所有的毛病修理好。

asap 立刻;馬上(出自 as soon as possible)

Hurry up! I need that report asap. 快點!我馬上要那份報告。

ask for it 自找麻煩;罪有應得

You were asking for it by driving around with bad brakes. 開刹車失靈的車是你自找麻煩。



That was an awesome party. Everybody had fun. 那個宴會 棒板了,每個人都玩得很高興。

back off 緩和;軟化;減輕

The city council had to back off from its criticism of the utility department. 市議會必須減輕對公共事業部門的批評。

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back out 退出(交易);叫停

Gegore backed out of the deal at the last minute. George 在 最後一刻退出交易。

back, put something on the back burner 暫時擱置

Paul was so busy that he had to put several projects on the back burner. Paul 忙得必須把幾個計劃暫時擱置下來。

backseat driver 在後座指導駕駛開車的人;好爲人師;不在其 位而謀其政

Please be quite, I can't concentrate with so many backseat drivers in the car. 安靜點,那麼多人教我開車,我無法專心。





back at square one 回到起點,白費力氣

It's really frustrating! After so much effort, I'm back at square one. 真洩氣!我費了那麼多力氣結果是白忙一場。

bad 太棒了 [講反話]

That outfit is bad. Where can I get one? 那套衣服棒透了,那 裡可以買到?

bad blood 嫌隙;不和;敵意

Ever since Howard borrowed 5,000 dollars from Mike and

never paid him back, there has been bad blood between them. 自從 Howard 向 Mike 借了 5,000 元不還之後,他們之間就有了嫌隙。

bad-mouth 說壞話

barf 嘔吐

When Amy was sick, she barfed all night. Amy 生病,吐了一晚。

barge in 闖入

Geroge rudely barged in on our private meeting. George無 遭地闖入我們的私下會談。

basket case 絕望無助、意志消沈的人

When Sam's wife left him, he was a basket case for weeks. Sam 的太太離開他時,他消沈了好幾個星期。

beat a dead horse 白費唇舌,白費力氣

I've already made up my mind. There's no sense beating a dead horse. 我已經下了決心,不必再白費唇舌了。

beat it 走開

Beat it! I'm busy right now. 走開!我現在忙著。

beats me 我不知道

Beats me. We haven't learned that yet. 我不知道,我們還沒有學到那個。

This is a private matter. It's none of your beeswax. 這是個人的事,和你無關。


belly laugh 震耳欲聾的笑聲

bent out of shape 氣壞了;大發雷霆


Mother is really bent out of shape because we came home so late last night. 我們昨晚遲歸,母親大發雷霆。

I don't know what the solution is. Right now, I'm caught between a rock and a hard place. 我不知道如何解決,現在我進退 兩難。



big 重要的;受歡迎的,熱門的

Michael Jackson is a big name in the music business. Michael Jackson 在音樂界是個響噹噹的名字。

Her new novel is really big in New York. 她的新小說在紐約 很紅。

big deal 重要的事

It's no big deal. I don't mind helping you out. 這沒什麼大不了的,我不介意幫助你。

big idea, What's the big idea? 什麼意思?!

What is the big idea? I don't appreciate all the personal questions. 什麼意思?! 我可不喜歡被問這些私人問題。

big league, hit the big leagues / time 更上一層樓

He's not a small time accountant anymore. With his new job, he's definitely hit the big leagues. 他不再是個小會計了,有了新工作,他的確更上一層樓。

big man on campus 學生領袖;校園風雲人物

Rick is the captain of the football team. He's the big man on campus. Rick 是足球隊長,是校園風雲人物。

big picture (事情的) 主要部份; 重點

Concentrate on the big picture for now. Don't worry about the minor details. 先把精神集中在重點上,不要擔心次要的細節。



big cheese

big shot (= VIP, big cheese, big wheel) 大人物,大頭

You can tell John is a big shot; he rides in a limousine

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
