
内 容 提 要


Picture 1: The Royal Coat of Arms of

Preface

This book is an attempt to present a picture of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the United States of America by conveying necessary information about them and to provide Chinese readers, who show a general interest in the two countries, with material written in intermediate English.

It differs from other books covering the similar theme in its unique arrangement.

First, all the materials are carefully selected and arranged in topics. The United Kingdom and the United States are similar in many respects, with a shared language and similar but not always same political, social, and economic values. Each has a sense of relation with the other. However, there are significant distinctions making a comparison useful to know the two countries better. There is more material in the book than could be easily covered in a single semester. Accordingly, it has been organized in such a way as to facilitate breaking it up for teaching.

Second, keywords are highlighted in bold, making the important information more noticeable.

Third, questions for discussion are offered at the end of most sections. This will allow the instructor to assign exercises that are appropriate for the material covered.

The book is a cooperation of three experienced teachers in Zhejiang Gongshang University. Chapter Two & Three, Supplementary Material Two & Three, Appendix Two and part of Appendix Three are compiled by Sun Lizhong, Chapter Seven and Chapter Eight by Shang Zhen and the rest by Jiang Dan.

The book owes to Professors Liu Fagong, Xu Jun and Wang Shuwen for their encouragement and support during the long writing process.
