



## Explanation

The English Section of the Index covering a period of seventy-three years from 1858-1931 includes thirty-six publications in addition to nineteen Chinese publications occasionally containing articles written in foreign languages. A periodical which has changed its name with the number of issue being continued is considered as one periodical. There are over 6000 entries included in the Index representing about 6000 articles. List of English publications indexed is found on page iv in this Section.

To each entry one or more subject headings are assigned depending upon the number of subject headings which an entry requires. A general subject heading directs to specific subject headings of its cognate subject matter by multiple cross references, e. g. Fruit, *See also* Apples, etc.. Subject headings of cognate subject matter are given in order of relative importance. A reciprocal index is inserted, e. g. Drainage *See also* Irrigation; Irrigation, *See also* Drainage. A single cross reference is used when there are two names having the same meaning, e. g. Groundnuts, *See* Peanuts; or when one subject heading is included in another, e. g. Rent, *See* Farm tenancy.

In compiling the Index, the Agricultural Index published by the H. W. Wilson Co. U. S. A., has been often consulted, especially for the choice of subject headings. The order in each entry is as follows: the title of the article; the author; the illustrations; the name of the publication abbreviated; the number of the issue; the paging; and the date. For example, an entry under Agricultural education, "Agricultural education for China under missionary influence. C. W. Groff. il Chi Recorder 45:158-64 Mr '14", indicates the illustrated article entitled "Agricultural education for China under missionary influence" by C. W. Groff, appeared in Chinese Recorder vol 45 on the pages 158-64 of the issue of March, 1914, is on the subject of Agricultural education. A parenthesis containing the number of the issue is substituted for a colon when the paging of a volume is not continuous or when the publication has no volume number.
