► Original Message

► Correction

I was very pleased to meet you too and I enjoyed the time we spent talking together. I have been working from 7:00 a. m. until now. I am very tired. After tomorrow I will write again. Please contact me when you have time and be good. I hope to see you very soon.

► Comments

1. The action took place in the past so the present tense is incorrect in the first sentence.
2. The use of pleased instead of glad is more commonly used.
3. Preposition for after talked is wrong; it should be to.



4. Pretty tired is an expression you might use in speech but in writing it is wrong.
5. In the next sentence the word more is ambiguous and incorrect. Does the writer mean again or in length?
6. The personal pronoun I is missing from the beginning of the next sentence. Even in short messages it is better to do things correctly and in full especially when you are learning English.
7. Finally sooner is a comparative and can only be used when talking about two different times.

► Comments

1. Use of am: The present tense is incorrect.
2. Incorrect spellings: advantures.
3. The present continuous tense am reading should be the past continuous.
4. The use of wish and hope is often confused. In this particular case talking about something in the distant future it is better to use hope. Sometimes either word can be used, but wish is more commonly used when the outcome is less certain. In the last line hope should again be used.

► Comments

1. This student used to have a very good level of English, as can be seen by some of the vocabulary and phrases she tries to use. The level has deteriorated because she does not use, or practise the language regularly. Language is like sport. You have to practise it daily in order to stay at your peak.
2. I know you are think about for me. It can be thinking of me or thinking about me but not for me.
3. A common one: The word common has a derogatory meaning. It means a person does not care what others think about him. He/she acts with no manners and as if they have not been educated. This is not what the writer intends to say. She means that she has not high ambitions.
4. Success is a noun. She has used it twice, firstly in the place of an adjective, and secondly in the place of the infinitive of the verb to succeed.
5. This writer has a liking for the word common. In the last sentence usual would be more appropriate.



► 参考译文
