编写说明

近几年,初中毕业、升学考试正经历着重大的改革。一是毕业考试、升学考试的模式多种多样,既有两考结合或部分结合的,也有两考分离的;二是考试不再限于省(市)、自治区统一组织命题,许多省(市)都由地区级负责命题,且考试科目及各科所占分值各地也不尽相同;三是2004年首次出现了课改实验区的新模式,虽然只涉及了17个实验区,但其代表了中考改革的方向。实验区的初中毕业、升学考试按照规定是单独命题,单列招生计划,单独录取。但无论如何,现阶段初中毕业生升学还需经过考试,即使考试成绩不再是升学录取的惟一依据,但还是升学录取的重要依据。不论谁来组织命题,各地所依据的命题指导思想和命题原则都是一致的,考试范围也都是初中所学过的课程。正因为如此,所有试题对各地考生才有普遍的参考价值。

如今,中考越来越受到考生和家长的重视。了解各地升学考试的考查科目,各科考题的命题形式等更是大家急切想了解的内容,我们编写此书的初衷正是为了帮助考生和家长以最简便快捷的方式更广泛地了解各地中考的实际"战例",从而得到启发,更有效地进行复习备考。

本书有如下特点:

- 1. 试题来源广泛,入选本书的既有省级中考试题,也有地区级的考题,且所有试题都是中考真题,既有广泛性,又有典型性。
- 2.考虑到 2005 年课改实验区的升学考试方式会有更大范围的推广,本书也收录 了实验区初中毕业生学业考试的真题,供广大考生借鉴。
- 3.本书分语文、数学、英语、物理、化学、政治 6 册。从全国中考情况看,语文、数学、英语是各地的必考科目,物理、化学、政治是大部分地区要考查的科目,而历史、文科综合、理科综合等则是部分地区的选考科目,为了方便考生参考、借鉴,我们在物理、化学册中选用了部分理化卷、理科综合卷,政治册中选用了政史卷、文科综合卷。
- 4.每套试题都有参考答案与解题提示,由于时间限制,每道题的解答不是特别详细,不够明了的地方考生可请老师指导。

我们在此对积极为本书提供资料的学校和老师,在编写过程中给予指导和帮助的 众多专家一并表示衷心地感谢。书中的错误和不足,诚恳地请读者批评指正。






