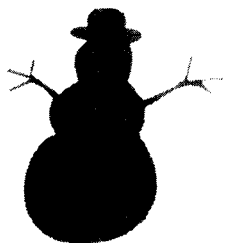

让你的发音听起来像美国人一样！

Brian 英语强调发音的重要性，发音是一个人的门面，发音不过关，单词量再大，考试分数再高，都会让人产生不公正的判断——认为你的英文 just so so；相反如果你的发音纯正，并且地道，即使你的英语基础并不太好，也会让老外觉得你的英文不错，所以我们一定要把发音摆在非常重要的位置上。

我的建议是在初期大量模仿国外原声磁带，或者听 VOA 慢速英语，边听边看原文，有人说到哪里找 VOA 慢速英语呢？送给大家一个好网址：[www.putclub.org/daily.htm](http://www.putclub.org/daily.htm) 只要大家上网就可以学到最地道的英文！网络在我学英语的过程中，帮了我大忙。因为国外英文网站上的材料是最新、最地道的英文。
