

Story One

Treasure in Our Daily Life

日常生活中的财富







On Strawberry Street every day of the week is recycling (再循环) day! On Monday Peter bundles (捆) old newspapers and ties them with string. Ben hauls(拖, 拉) the bundles to the curb for recycling truck to pick up.

"New things can be made from trash," Ben explains." We don't like to waste, so we recycle! "







"Hey, Peter and Ben!" calls Oliver. "Check(查看) out our trash treasures(宝藏)."

"It's a party!" Oliver and his friends are using old newspaper to make hats, airplanes and kites.





"We are the first recyclers(再循环利用者) because we keep our trash and use it again! See? We turn trash into treasure. Heh-heh-heh!"







On Tuesday Emmy's Mum brings home used paper from the office. Emmy draws pictures on the back of the paper. Emmy knows that saving(节约) paper saves trees.

"Look!" says Emmy. "Emmy made a tree. Emmy loves, loves trees."











On Wednesday little Mike flattens (铺平) out empty cardboard (纸板) boxes so they can be recycled. "Cardboard is made of paper, too," says Mike, "Old cardboard can be made into new cardboard!"







On Thursday Mr and Mrs White return empty bottles and cans (罐子) to the recycle store. First they count the empties. Then they count the money!







"Wonderful! Forty—one bottles and cans!" says the couple. "We get two dollars and five cents back! Thank you."





Oliver keeps empty bottles and cans and turns them into musical instruments (F F). Outside the store Oliver's Tin Can Band gives a concert (F F).

"All right!" yells Oliver. "Plays it! Trash to treasure. That's the way we live."







On Friday Peggy collects her aluminum (鋁) cans and plastic(塑料的) bottles. Then she sorts (把……分类,拣选) empty glass bottles and jars into different crates. There's one crate for clear glass, one for green, and one for brown. "Old glass can be cleaned and used again," says Peggy. "This is an excellent(很好的,棒极了) way to recycle!"

But why is Peggy saving old bottle caps?





Peggy saves bottle caps so she can give them to Mary. Mary uses the bottle caps to make jewelry $(\mathfrak{R}\hat{\mathbf{x}})$.

"Trash to treasure," says Mary, "That's the way we live."
