前 言

随着四个现代化建设的发展以及国际科技文化的广泛交流,我国日益需要大量精通外语的人才,特别是英语方面的人才。目前高等院校采用的《大学英语教学大纲》反映了国家培养四化建设高级人才的要求和规格。我们选编这部《大学英语听力测验》正是体现了《大纲》在听力方面的教学目的,以利于提高学生的语言能力。

《大学英语听力测验》根据分级教学的需要,分(1—4)级选编发行,本书属(1—3)级听力实践和测验,它有四盒录音磁带,包含:

1 级听力实践。

其中有 80 个单句、60 组对话。题材熟悉,句子结构简单,基本上没有生词,语速每分钟约 100 词。语言点按先后次序相对集中。教师可按学生的实际情况、根据需要,每次操练 5—10 个单句或 4—8 组对话,放音 2—3 遍,使学生对发音、连读和口语化简缩词的读音以及各种语法现象和语言内容,通过声响来辨别理解。(1 级占一盒磁带)

2 级听力测验。

按照陕西省高等院校大学英语 2 级统考大纲听力要求的模式,我们编写了 8 套模拟试题,每套题约 15 分钟。各题读两遍,两遍之间的间歇为 20 秒钟,以供多项选择答题。题材为一般性文章,句子结构简单,没有生词。语速约每分钟 100 词,相当于 VOA 电台慢速英语节目。各套模拟试题的形式相同,均有 4 个单句,3 组对话及一段短文。理解准确率以 70% 为合格。(2 级占两盒磁带)

3 级听力实践。

这是《4 级听力测验》的准备阶段。参照全国大学英语 4 级统考题的模式,即 10 组对话,三篇短文,每篇后有若干问题。题材熟悉,句子结构

比较简单，基本上没有生词，语速每分钟约 120 词。教师可按学生的实际情况，根据需要，单项操练或综合测试。放音二遍，理解准确率以 70% 为合格。（3 级占一盒磁带）

本书的全部内容均配有文字材料和答案。所提供的录音磁带的语音、语调规范，语速及停顿时间完全按《大纲》规定的指标。本套磁带特聘外籍专家录制，以利于提高学生听力的适应能力。

在编选本书的过程中曾得到我校副校长蒋德明教授的大力支持。国家教委公外编委委员、西安交大外语系副主任潘能副教授为全书作了审校，在此我们表示衷心的感谢。

由于编者水平有限，加上时间仓促，不足之处，请读者批评指正。
