# 试题详解

#### Section A

- 1. 正确选项为 C),属于简单推断型题。题目问:女士的话是什么意思? 男士问女士看到 Martha 没有,女士的回答"you might still be able to catch her"是关键,由此可推断出男士还有可能找到她。因此,选项 C)符合题意。
- 2. 正确选项为 A),属于简单推断型题。题目问:男士的话是什么意思? 女士说她受不了这个城市的污染了。男士话中的"We've never had so many factories before."是解题的关键,由此可判断是由于太多的工厂导致了更严重的污染。因此,选项 A)为正确答案。
- 3. 正确选项为 B),属于细节型题。题目问:女士的话暗指什么意思? 男士说他为完成论文做了很努力的工作,但只得了个 C。关键要听懂女士话中的"What you have learned in the process will prove useful in your future work."(你在此过程中所学到的东西会在以后的工作中证明是很有用的)。其中 go through 的意思为"完成"。与此意

相符的只有选项 B)。

- 4. 正确选项为 B),属于细节型题。题目问:女士的话是什么意思? 男士说周六晚想出去吃饭,征求女士的意见去哪里吃。关键要听懂女士话中的"It's up to vou."(由你做决定)。故选项 B)正确。
- 5. 正确选项为 D),属于主旨大意型题。题目问:我们能从对话中得出什么信息? 女士说没有男士的帮助她是不会获奖的,关键要听清男士的话"You have been working so hard. You deserve the honor."表明女士一直都很努力,应该获奖。此题必须要弄清是谁获奖了,谁在感谢谁。故正确选项为 D)。
- 6. 正确选项为 C),属于主旨大意型题。题目问:女士的话暗指什么意思? 男士说他想要和环境委员会签约参与志愿者工作,女士回答中的"So you must leave some room in scheduling your time."是解题的关键。她认为男士要参加志愿者工作会花费很多时间,所以男士必须要留出余地来安排好他的时间。故根据题意,选项 C)正确。
- 7. 正确选项为 B),属于细节型题。题目问:医生的话是什么意思? 女士问医生她何时可以离开医院,关键要听清医生的话"You may leave as soon as the bleeding stops.",故选项 B)符合题意。
- 8. 正确选项为 A),属于简单推断型题。题目问:女士的话是什么意思? 男士听说 Alice 要在一家电器公司找工作,听懂并正确理解女士话中的"she is good at anything but electronics"是关键,特别注意but 在读时被重读,表示"除了",由此可推断 Alice 在电子方面并不擅长。因此选项 A)与题意相符。
- 9. 正确选项为 C),属于简单推断型题。题目问:女士的话是什么意思? 男士问是否举行一个告别晚宴为 Jimmy 送行,从女士的"Do you think it's necessary?"中就可判断出她觉得没有必要这样做,而且从她的后一句"...he will be away just a few days"(他过几天就回来了),也可进一步证明。故选项 C)符合题意。
  - 10. 正确选项为 D),属于主旨大意型题。题目问:我们能从对话

中得出什么信息? 迅速浏览各备选项,发现主语都是 the woman,所以在听时要特别注意听懂女士所说的话。男士认为昨晚女士应打电话给他,女士为此而道歉,接着说明了理由"but Tom and Jane stopped by and stayed until Midnight",其中 stop by 的意思是"顺便到某处访问",因此只有选项 D)正确。

#### Section B

## Passage One

- 11. 正确选项为 C),属于推理型题。题目问:根据说话者所说,乘车上下班者坐车穿过金门大桥时他们有怎样的感受? 本文开头谈到每天有 100,000 辆车通过金门大桥,并且"More than half of them cross the bridge during the morning and evening rush hours when traffic is so heavy the trip is not pleasant."(半数以上的车辆都在早高峰和晚高峰通过金门大桥,那时交通很拥挤,旅程也不令人愉快)。由此可推断,那些坐车的人心情应该不会很好,不会感到高兴(delighted, pleased)和害怕(frightened)的,因此可排除选项 A),B)和 D)。选项 C)中 irritated 的意思是"恼怒的,生气的",jam 的意思是"堵塞,塞满"。故选项 C)符合题意。
- 12. 正确选项为 D),属于主旨大意型题。题目问:关于渡船上下班者,说话者说了什么? 本文说话者重点谈了渡船上下班者与众不同之处。短文提到"Commuters can enjoy the sun ... The trip takes only 30 minutes and is not very costly ... Best of all, being on a boat seems to make people more friendly toward each other. "从中我们可了解到:渡船上下班者可享受太阳光的照射,旅程只有 30 分钟,花费也不高。不过最好的一点就是大家坐在船里好像使得彼此更加友好了。迅速浏览各备选项,只有选项 D)正确。
- 13. 正确选项为 B),属于推理型题。题目问:对于渡船未来的计划,渡船上下班者的反应如何? 短文的最后谈到了渡船未来的计划。有人建议用更大、速度更快的船。"but"—词表转折,要特别注意 but

后面的话 "not everyone is happy about that. A lot of people feel that half an hour is just enough time to relax.",说明很多人觉得半个小时正好是一个可以充分放松的时间,也就是说他们还愿意保持原来的船速不变。因此选项 B)与题意相符。

#### Passage two

- 14. 正确选项为 A),属于事实细节型题。题目问:根据短文所说,哪种食物最容易腐蚀牙齿? 短文中提到"He pointed out that sugar is a major agent in dental decay. Particularly the sugar in sweets, cakes, and soft drinks."备选项所提及的四种食物中只有可口可乐属于饮料,与题意相符,故选项 A)正确。
- 15. 正确选项为 B),属于事实细节型题。题目问:短文告诉我们有关 Dr. Faustick 牙齿现状的什么信息? 短文中明确谈到"Dr. Faustick has cleaned his teeth after meal for thirteen years and has not had a single decayed tooth." 本题属于信息再现,听到的就是答案。因此选项 B)正确。
- 16. 正确选项为 B),属于主旨大意型题。题目问:为防止牙齿腐蚀变坏,Dr. Faustick 给了我们什么建议?回答本题需要听清并了解短文的大意。不管从短文前部分 Dr. Faustick 所做的实验和调查,还是其后部分他做出的分析中都可以看出通篇他都在讲一个问题——吃完东西后应立即清理牙齿。因此选项 B)符合题意。

### Passage three

17. 正确选项为 A),属于事实细节型题。题目问:最初是什么使得 Henri Dunant 想要帮助那些受到压迫的人们? 此篇短文讲述的是 Henri Dunant 创办红十字会的经历和过程。短文开头就提到红十字会来源于一瑞士银行家的理想。在他 10 岁的时候,"Dunant was taken by his father to visit a prison, there he saw prisoners chained together exercising in the yard and breaking stones along the road."就是这次经历给

他留下了深刻的印象,使他萌发了为受压迫的人们做点什么的念头。 故选项 A)符合题意。

- 18. 正确选项为 C),属于主旨大意型题。题目问:在法国和奥地利军队作战时,Henri Dunant 做了什么? 他目睹了法国和奥地利军队的残酷战争,看到当时药品匮乏,伤员缺少必要的护理,他感到很震惊,于是"Dunant decided that volunteer service had to be organized. He gathered together a number of women who attended the hundreds of wounded soldiers of all nationalities and helped the surgeons as best they could."由此可以总结其大意为:发动和组织志愿者照顾伤员。因此只有选项C)与题意相符。其中 recruit 的意思是"补充,征募"。
- 19. 正确选项为 D),属于事实细节型题。题目问:Henri Dunant 创办红十字会时他的信条是什么? 短文中提到了 Henri Dunant 的主张,"Dunant held that a suffering human being should be helped for his own sake only and without regard to race, religion, or political beliefs."即他认为任何一个患病的人都应得到帮助,不管他的种族、宗教及政治信仰如何。故选项 D)正确,其中 be entitled to 的意思是"有资格做,有权做"。
- 20. 正确选项为 C),属于事实细节型题。题目问:为什么把红十字会的会标设计为白地红十字? 短文最后提到了红十字会会标的诞生,"As a tribute to Switzerland, the symbol was the Swiss flag was reversed."为了表达对瑞士的感激,把瑞士国旗(图案)的颜色对换过来,于是诞生了红十字会会标。因此选项 C)正确。
