# 前言

为了全面贯彻落实教育部关于加强我国外语教学改革的指示精神,经中国教育学会外语教学专业委员会第六届理事会研究决定举办首届全国中学生英语写作大赛。本套丛书即根据此次大赛精神,按照《中学英语课程标准》关于写作的具体要求,精心编写而成。
