Her name is Joan. 她的名字叫琼。

#### 2. is v. 是

系动词 be 包括 am, is, are。人称不同,系动词的形式也不同。第一人称单数 I 用 am, 第三人称单数用 is,第二人称和各种复数人称用 are。

5. first name 名字; last name 姓

first name 相当于 given name; last name 相当于 family name。







#### 姓名

- 2. 名 + 第二名字(常是父、母等长辈的名或姓)+ 姓,如: Edward Adam Davis。
- 3. 名字常有昵称,如: 称 David 为 Dave, 称 Tom 为 Tommy。
- 4. 妇女婚后常随夫姓,如: Marie Curie。

#### 称谓

- 1. Mr / Ms / Mrs / Miss + 姓 (或加姓名),如: Mr Wilson (或 Mr John Wilson)。
- 2. 除 Dr / Prof / Captain 等少数词外, 一般表职务、职业或职称的词不用于称谓,如: 不说 Teacher Wang。
- 3. 亲朋好友之间,常直呼其名或昵称,如: David 或 Dave;但对亲戚长辈,常用"称呼 + 名",如: Uncle Tom。





