


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前言

为什么要编写《中、高考考点精解精练大全》这套书呢? 我们不妨从考点说起。

什么是考点?考点就是考纲规定测试的知识能力要求的切入点。这是一个抽象的概念。具体体现考点知识能力要求的是各种类型的"题"。因为"题"是知识能力要求的一种具体表达方式,是知识能力的载体。所以通过"题"来诠释考点,是最恰当不过的。而考生通过解题,来把握考点,提高运用知识解决问题的能力,也是获取优异成绩的关键之所在。正因如此,受北京教育出版社和北京路丽梅图书编辑中心之约,我们特邀全国著名特级教师、中国教育台高考各科主讲人为学科主编,编写了这套《中、高考考点精解精练大全》供全国考生参加 2005 年中、高考复习使用。

为了通过考点精解、精练帮助考生取得优异的成绩,考上自己理想的学校,在丛书编写中,我们特别注意解决了以下问题。

一、洗材"精"

本书所选之题,均系近五年(含 2004 年)中、高考经典试题。这些题都是由全国或各省、市专家命题组根据中学各科教学大纲、课程标准和中考考纲、高考考试说明规定的考试范围和知识能力要求精心编制的。它是专家集体智慧的结晶,也是考改成果的体现,而这些人选的题所涉及的内容,基本上做到了横有跨度,纵有深度,具有"全、新、深"的特点,并由相应考点构成一个良性的知识能力网络,而覆盖全部考试内容。所以,用这些题来对考点进行解析,复习起点高,针对性强,全面深人、有预测性。

二. 解析"精"

本丛书采取试题分类解析法,全书以各考点为中心,分别集结近年该考点所涉各类试题,用比较法对试题进行讲解。重点帮助考生分析这类试题的命题思路、解题方法、技巧和运用知识解题的规律等,以培养和提高考生发散思维和创新思维能力。这种以考点为单元或者为小专题的解析方法,对教师来说,可从一点展开,对该考点所涉题群隐含的问题,进行全方位、多层次、多角度的深层分析和进行科学的总结、归纳。对学生来说,一是难点分散,便于各个突破;二是比较复习,便于把握知识的内在联系与区别;三是由分解到综合地复习,便于掌握运用知识解决问题的规律。由此可见,对考点进行"精解"的复习法,由于始终围绕考点的知识能力要求这个中心做文章,所以能使考生的复习深入而到位,精练而高效。

三、练习"精"

为巩固考生已学知识及运用知识解决问题的能力,本丛书以中学各科教学大纲、课程标准及中考考纲、高考考试说明对各科考试科目规定的考测知识能力要求为准绳,以近年全国高考和各省市中考的试题为蓝本,并汲取全国各省市会考题、模拟考试题、各类竞赛题的精华,按各科考点,逐一精心编选了同层级的单一性和综合性能力训练题,供考生对应考点复习使用。由于这些题完全受考点知识能力的规范,所以在知识范围和能力要求上,以及题型难易度上都与试题完全一致,而且在命题思路与角度上"求新""求变",具有预测功能,这样,便可使考生在"精解"的基础上,进行"举一反三"的能力训练,并把"精练"作为教师"精解"的自然延伸和补充,从根本上提高考生的应试能力。

由此可见,《中、高考精解精练大全》的确是一套以经典试题为蓝本,融解析和同步能力训练为一体的复习备考指导丛书。是参加全国中、高考考生复习考试攻坚的锐利武器。

我们深信,在名师的指点下,考生如能坚持在全面复习的基础上,学好、用好这套丛书,就一定会迈着轻松的步伐跨进理想学校的大门。
