

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前言

《PETS 备考系列教程》(英文书名: *Success With PETS*)是按照国家教育部考试中心制定的“全国公共英语等级考试体系”要求所编写的一整套备考教程。“全国公共英语等级考试体系”的英文名是: China Public English Test System, 简称 PETS, 是一种面向社会、含有 5 个等级的目标参照性英语考试体系。

本套教程共有 5 册, 每一级为 1 册, 可用作课堂教学, 也可供学生自学使用。本套教程的设计以当代第二语言习得的理论和实践的研究成果为指导, 紧扣 PETS 考试大纲的各项要求, 突出备考的特点, 以满足考生应考的需求。同时, 作为一套教程, 其课文选材及各类练习的编写, 突出语言的交际性特点, 而且在内容上注重时代性、知识性、趣味性和可思性; 在练习的形式上注重多样性和灵活性, 目的是提高学习者的兴趣以及在不同的交际情景下灵活运用语言的能力。

本册为第 1 册, 有 12 个单元, 每个单元由 4 部分组成:(1)准备活动(Tune In); (2)听力训练(Listen); (3)阅读与讨论(Read and Discuss); (4)口语与写作(Speak and Write)。

每个单元围绕一个主题展开, 主题的选择以考试大纲的“交际话题表”为依据。练习形式包括了 PETS 一级笔试和口试所涉及的所有内容。如: 听力中的“图片判断”、“对话理解”, 英语知识运用中的选择题、完形填空题, 阅读理解中的词语配伍, 等等。每个单元的阅读材料包含 3 篇文章。其中第 1 篇为主课文, 课后练习涉及阅读理解、词汇、语法、口语等多项训练内容, 并配以多种训练形式。其余两篇课文后的练习也涉及阅读理解、词汇、语法等内容。口语和写作练习注重实用性, 如看图说话、看图写短文以及写短信等。

在部分单元后, 有“Exam Tips”专栏, 向考生介绍一些应试技巧方面的内容, 主要针对 PETS 一级考试的各种形式。

附录 1 提供练习试卷, 包含 4 套笔试模拟试卷和 2 套口试模拟试卷。试卷严格参照 PETS 一级考试样卷, 为学生提供自我检测。

考虑到第 1 册的主要使用对象为一级考生, 这些考生已学过英语, 具有相当于初中毕业生的英语水平, 因此对课文中的词汇处理, 我们只对超一级大纲的单词标注了中文意思。附录 4 提供总词汇表, 它既包含了一级大纲内的单词、词组, 也包含了课文训练中出现过的生词, 这样既可以使考生了解大纲对词汇的要求范围, 也有助于考生扩大词汇量, 为更高级别的考试作准备。词表中带 * 号的是在本书课文里出现的超纲词, 后面的数字表示其首次出现的单元和课文。例如: * safe 011 即表示“safe”首次出现在 Unit One, Text I 中。

本教程还提供全部的单元练习、模拟试卷答案, 以及听力部分的原文。

为了帮助考生更好地了解 PETS 和 PETS 一级考试, 本书对 PETS 一级考试的标准、形式作了简单、明了的介绍。

PETS 一级考试简介

PETS 为“全国公共英语等级考试体系”—— China Public English Test System 的英文缩写,由教育部考试中心设计、开发,并得到了英国国际发展部及英国剑桥大学地方考试委员会的支持,是中英文化交流的合作项目。

PETS 的目标和宗旨是:在全国范围内推动英语的普及与提高;完善各种考查手段,尤其是听、说方面的考测方法;合理设置各级考试的评价标准,科学地界定各种考查要求的关系;提高考试的信度,使考生成绩使用多样化,为考生就业和招生考试改革服务。

PETS 第一级考试级别标准

PETS 第 1 级是“全国公共英语等级考试体系”5 个级别的初始级,其标准略高于我国九年制义务教育全日制初级中学毕业时的英语水平。

该级别考生应具有的语言知识:

1. 语法知识

该级考生应能适当运用基础的语法知识。第 1 级在语法方面的要求主要参照了我国现行九年义务教育全日制初中英语教学大纲。

2. 词汇知识

该级考生应能掌握 1,000 左右的词汇以及若干相关的常用词组。

第 1 级词表涉及该级别语言的功能性使用。此外,出于交际的需要,考生应自行掌握涉及个人好恶、生活习惯、宗教信仰,以及本人工作或专业等方面 的特殊词汇。

3. 语言运用

该级考生在背景清晰的情况下,可以用英语与外国人交谈,表达问候、感谢以及交换特定信息,诸如价格、日期、指路等。

该级考生能听懂熟悉的日常生活中发音清楚、语速较慢的简短对话。能读简单的通知、便条、留言、图表以及简短故事。

该级考生能写出简短的私人信函或便条转达具体信息。

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- 听力：第1节要求考生根据所听到的10个单句，从每题所给的3个选项中选出最佳选项。第2节要求考生根据所听到的15段短对话，从每题所给的3个选项中选出最佳选项。
- 英语知识运用：第1节要求考生根据句子或简短对话，从每题所给的3个选项中选出最佳选项。其中有10—12道题考查语法结构，3—5道题考查单词和表达方式。第2节完形填空，在一篇90—120词的短文中留出10个空白，要求考生从每题所给的3个选项中选出最佳选项。
- 阅读理解：第1节考生须将5个定义与7个选项中正确的单词搭配成对。第2节要求考生根据所提供的1篇长度为175—200词的短文的内容，从每题所给的“正、误、未提及”3个选项中选择其一。第3节要求考生根据所提供的2篇长度为175—200词的短文的内容，从每题所给的3个选项中选出最佳选项。
- 写作：第1节要求考生根据所提供的3个句子，在给出的每个新句子的空白处填上1—5个关键的单词而不改变原有句子的意思。第2节考查考生写出3—5条信息的简短信函和便条的能力。
- 口试：第1节考查考生初次见面时向他人提供个人的事实性信息(如姓名、出生地、职业、爱好等)的能力。第2节，考查考生根据信息卡内容就具体事实互相问答的能力。信息卡分为提问卡和回答卡，内容涉及日常生活、爱好等。





Read the Text

San Francisco

Weather and geography make San Francisco a pleasant but sometimes frightening place to live. Lying on the end of a peninsular in northern California, the city enjoys a mild cli-

mate, although it is often cool and wet. San Francisco is well-known for its fog, low temperatures and rain even in the summer. People living there may suggest that you bring coats even if you visit it in July. But winter is not very cold because the weather is made mild by the warm air and water of the Pacific Ocean.

The weather of nearby areas is, in contrast, much warmer and drier. A few miles away from the ocean, the summers are very dry and free of fog. Daytime temperatures are sometimes 35°C. The temperatures in winter usually do not fall below 0°C even in January.

While the climate is pleasant, the danger of earthquakes is not. As in many parts of California, earthquakes are a major worry for people who live in the San Francisco area. In 1906, an earthquake destroyed most of the city. People know an earthquake will happen there again. They know this, but they are not afraid of it. They seem to be used to living with the danger. Some even store food and other necessities and build houses that can bear the stress that an earthquake may bring. 15

Although there is danger, few people leave. "This is a beautiful place, and there are problems everywhere. No place is 100% safe," said one man who has spent his life in San Francisco.
