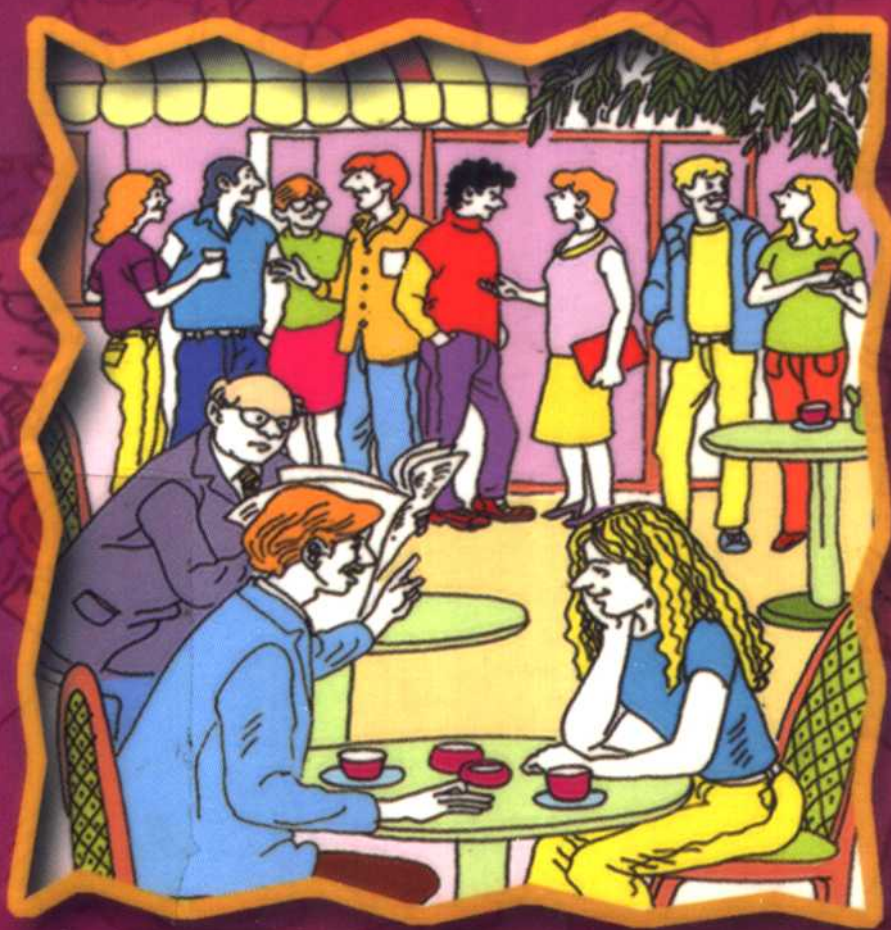

《脱口说英语》是北航出版社向广大有意学习英语的朋友们奉献的一套以口语为主的小册子。这套《脱口说英语》共有三册，每册独立成章，读者可以随身携带，学习、模仿、练习。每册书还另配有录音磁带两盒，既可以按照录音模仿纯正的英语口语，也可以把录音作为听力材料使用，读者可以根据需要整套购买或分册选购。

《脱口说英语》第一册《最新美国口语精选·基础美语 400 句》由周安石和周来主编，《脱口说英语》第二册《生活英语口语精选》和第三册《实用英语口语精选》由曾宪宇主编。全部录音分别由 Paul Denman, Claire Davies, Julia, John, Joseph 等录制。

为了方便读者使用，这套《脱口说英语》全部采用英汉对照形式排版，英语排在单数页，汉语参考译文排在双数页。这样，既便于读者使用英语原文，而找到汉语参考译文也很便捷。

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1. 到你们家怎么走?

保罗刚刚到达车站就打电话给罗勃问到他家怎么走。

(电话铃声)

罗勃: 喂。

保罗: 喂, 保罗, 我是罗勃。我刚刚到车站。你能告诉我到你家怎么走吗?

罗勃: 我来接你吧。

保罗: 不用, 我能找到。我有一张地图, 路不远, 是吧?

罗勃: 是的, 走路大约十分钟。或者你可以从车站乘 40 路汽车到学校下车。你真的不需要我去接你吗?

保罗: 不需要, 真的, 我愿意走路。

罗勃: 让我想想——你出了车站向右拐。一直向前走, 过了红绿灯, 再沿着路向前走——这条路是沿着河的——一直走到一个酒吧, 酒吧在路右边。向右拐正好经过这个酒吧, 沿着这条路向前走, 走到一个十字路口。

1. How Can I Get to Your House?

Paul has just arrived at the station and has phoned Rob to find out how to get to his house.

(sound of phone ringing)

Rob: Hello.

Paul: Hello Rob, it's Paul here. I've just arrived at the station. Can you tell me how to get to your house?

Rob: I'll come and meet you.

Paul: No, it's OK. I've got a street plan and it's not far is it?

Rob: No, about ten minutes' walk. Or else you could catch the number forty bus from the station and get off by the school. Are you sure you don't want me to meet you?

Paul: Yes, quite sure, I'd like to walk.

Rob: Let's see now — when you come out of the station, you turn right. Go straight across the traffic lights and walk along the road — it runs alongside the river — until you come to a pub on the right. Turn right just past it and walk up this road until you come to the crossroads.

左边有一个教堂。

保罗：对不起，你说什么？我没太听明白。

Paul: Sorry, what was that again? I didn't quite hear.

Rob: You turn third right just past the pub and walk along the road until you come to the crossroads. Have you got that?

Paul: Yes.

Rob: When you get there, you go straight across the crossroads and continue up this road until you come to a school on the right. Turn right just past it. Our house is the third on the left. Have you got the address?

Paul: Yes, 5 Primrose Road.

Rob: OK, I'll see you in about ten minutes then.

Paul: Yes, bye.

2. 昨天晚上你做什么了?

吉尔:昨天下班后你做什么了?

罗伯特:啊,嗯,噢,我到停车场对面的那个酒吧喝酒去了,我把车停在了那个停车场,在那儿碰到了简和汤姆。然后,噢,过了一会儿我们决定一块儿去吃晚饭。

吉尔:哦,你们到哪儿去吃的?

罗伯特:噢,我们开车到了 Oswald 路,呃,进了银行旁边的那个餐馆,但餐馆客满。所以我们就到了这条路的另一头,噢,进了那儿的另一家餐馆。

吉尔:哦,是这样。那儿的饭怎么样?
