

## 使用说明

预备级教材分《读与写》和《听与说》两册,是为 t能达到高等医学院校《英语教学大纲》所规定入学时应具有的英语水平的医学生编写的。其目的是重点复习和巩固中学所学过的英语知识及技能;增加一定数量的常用词汇;适当扩大语法知识,提高阅读水平;培养初步的听和说的能力。

本教材共有二十课,最后附一测验试题。前十七课和测验试题必须完成,后三课则由教师根据学生具体情况决定使用与否。其教学进度基本上按一学时一课进行。每项练习则可根据学生情况练习  $1\sim2$  遍,并由教师掌握。

预备级《听与说》教材基本上是以语音为主线编写的,每课均围绕一定的音素开展各种形式的听力训练,旨在培养学生最基本的听的能力。本教材共有二十课,最后附有一测验试题。前十七课和测验试题必须完成,后三课则由教师根据学生具体情况决定使用与否。教学进度基本上按一学时一课进行。每项练习也可根据学生情况练习 1~2 遍,并由教师掌握。

本教材每课分为第一和第二两个部分,其中第一部分是听音练习,第二部分是根据第一部分练习过的音素而编写的句子、对话或短文,是第一部分的扩展,目的是逐步培养学生听的理解能力。至于阅读短文及翻译训练,另有预备级《读与写》教材。

本教材除供入学时英语水平较低的五年制医学生使用外,尚可供三年制医学专科学生使用。

需要说明的是,预备级《听与说》教材在某些练习形式和内容方面与一级教材有一定的重叠。这样就为学生过渡到一级教材作了准备和减少了难度。当然,在编写听力教程方面我们尚缺乏经验,不当之处,甚至错误,在所难免,衷心欢迎使用本教材的老师和同学们批评指正。

本级教材完稿后经由美籍教师 James Gibbs 最后校读,谨此致以诚挚的谢意。
