一年前,编者曾收到一封北京来信。写信的老先生是原山东潍坊师专的丁倡佑教授,真教人喜出望外。吾生也晚,一九八六年前后,他已在全国英语试题标准化研究中成果卓著,似有南桂(诗春)北丁(昌佑)之谓。正因为如此,一九八八年我市特请他就英语试题标准化改革等作了专题讲座,反响热烈。说来也巧,十五年后,丁老已居于北京大女儿处,偶尔一次他在书店内看到了这本书并驰书告之:"这本书编排体列富有新意,便于读者查找,试题分析简明扼要,不失为一本不可多得的材料"等等。没想到拙著能受到这么一位有名的专家之关照,颇受宠若惊,亦实为幸事。

在现代中国,普通高等学校统一招生考试,乃是规模最大、最能牵动亿万人心的选拔性考试。它每年要为全国高等院校输送数百万名的新生,为国家选拔数百万名优秀后备人才。相比较而言,这种选拔性考试是客观的、公平的、公正的,在某种意义上来说,也是不可替代的。放眼全球,美国学生做梦也在想如何考上哈佛、斯坦福等大学,英国学生做梦也在想如何考上牛津、剑桥等大学,日本学生做梦也在想如何考上东京、早稻田等大学。再回到国内,清华园内、未名湖畔又是多少莘莘学子心驰神往的地方!有教育就有考试,有考试就有考试研究,这犹如日月经天,江河行地般的天经地义,无可厚非。研究高考有三条途径:一是研究《考试大纲》,主要研究它所规定的考试内容、能力要求、试卷结构,以求高考复习的针对性、实效性;二是研究高考中考生答题状况,了解其主要得失及其形成原因;三是研究历年高考试卷,系统的而不是孤立的,连续数年的而不是割裂开来的去研究高考试卷,对教师而言是一项教学与研究的基本功,对参加高考的学生来说是高考前的洗礼,是一次人生的感悟。前两点是比较容易做到的,而要做到后一点,只有通过对历年来高考试题的研究,才可以大致把握高考英语命题的基本特点、命题趋势、解题技巧等,从而收到事半功倍之效。

有鉴于此,本书编者集30多年教学、教研之经验,组织部分一线教师,认真搜集、研读最新十年高考英语试题,并就高考英语命题思路、解题技巧、命题趋势以及有关复习指导等进行了由表及里、去伪存真的探究,数易其稿,终成此书。

本书有以下特点:

- 1. 完整地提供了1995~2004年全国最近10年高考英语试题,从而保证了资料的权威性。这样做,理由有三:一、我们应提供完整的而不是支离破碎的最近10年的高考试题,让读者自己通览全卷,从中体察各年的命题思路,领悟未来的命题趋势,以培养考生高屋建瓴的能力;二、避免了按语法分类可能导致的不够科学的弊病。许多高考试题灵活多变,且考点互有交叉,有时很难将每题归纳到某种语法体系之内;三、高考试卷的命题趋势是逐渐淡化语法知识,越来越注重运用语言的能力,而这种能力的最高层次即是对语言的悟性和语感。
- 2. 将最近 10 年高考试题按有关题型逐一分类并进行评述,力图从理论和实践的高度,对每一小题作出解析与点拔,以期让广大读者能居高临下、触类旁通。这是本书的精华部分,当然也是作者智慧与功力之所在。
  - 3. 删去了有关高考被淘汰的题型。近年来,高考3+x题型删去了有关对语音、单词拼

写等这些考查项目,增加了听力考试内容。语音考查题比较死板,已被听力考查所替代,这是时代对交际语言的更高要求所致;删去"单词拼写"这一题型,则表明这一较低能力层次的考查不属选拔考试之列。但为了保留高考试题的原貌,本书所列的高考试题仍按原有题号逐一标出,以便读者查对。

4. 随着高考制度的改革,高考命题形式发生了很大变化。原来除北京、上海单独命题外,就只有"全国卷"。2004年新增单独命题的省市就有9个。即便是全国卷也有适应不同地区需要的四套。总计15套试卷。这些试卷,虽大多数都是依据国家考试中心编印的《考试大纲》命题的,但也有着适应本省市要求的"创意",这为我们研究高考试卷提供了更丰富的材料。研究这些试卷比苦做各地的模拟试题更有价值。

囿于水平和时间,本书失当之处在所难免,敬请读者朋友批评指正。








- 1. 冠词
- 2. 名词
- 3. 代词
- 4. 形容词、副词及它们的级
- 5. 连词
- 6. 介词
- 7. 数词
- 8. it 的用法
- 9. 动词(动词词组、非谓语动词、虚拟语气等)
- 10. 倒装
- 11、从旬
- 12. 情景交际及其他

最近5年来,高考试题中,单项选择这一题型的 考试,出现了以下一些命题趋势;

- 1. 纯语法项目的考题越来越少,取而代之的是 灵活多变的英语知识和能力的综合考查以及大量的 交际英语方面的情景对话题;
- 2. 四个备选选项中,应排除的三项越来越具有迷惑性。 考生如不考虑该题特定的语意情景,往往无从下笔,从语法角度上来看,难以选择正确答案;
- 3. 近年来,由于《英语课程标准》 越来越强调交际 关语以及运用英语的能力,这一题型的题量和赋值有逐渐减少的趋势。这一点,广大考生以及第一线的老师应有所了解。



考生在答题时,思维应清晰,主要应考虑到:

- 1. 细心审题,解析每一个考查要点;
- 2. 分析题于以及备选项所提供的全部信息;
- 3. 要注意所考查的语言语法项目在特定情景 下的特殊用法,尤其要排除母语的干扰;
- 4. 注意时态、语态、主动、被动以及结构一致性;
  - 5. 利用排他法排除干扰项;
- 6. 学会猜题也是一种技能,如无法判定正确答案,可选择表面上极不可能的选项。


