

















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出版前言

《新世纪少儿英语》(Look!)的原版从国际著名教材出版公司——朗文出版公司引进,由本社改编出版,为国际著名英语教育专家L.G.Alexander继《看、听、学》(3L)和《新概念英语》之后,根据非英语国家中小学生的实际情况专门编写出版的又一力作。教材共分6级,每级包括学生用书、练习册和教师用书各一册。本社出版的版本为英汉双语改编本。经过改编和注释,本教材更符合中国少儿外语教学需要。

本教程以语法为基础,注重大量扩充日常生活词汇,授课、练习及写作训练遵循一套设计合理而完善的基本程序。

学生用书每级各由30课组成,每课集中于一个基本语法点,并将听力训练和阅读内容与口语操练内容分置于左右页,清晰明确,有利于教师和学生针对不同的重点进行强化训练。各级难度循序渐进,坡度平缓,符合中小学生的学习心理和习惯。学完6册学生用书,学生词汇量可达1200词,能掌握英语语言中的所有基本语法点,听懂简单的会话和故事,并能用所学词汇进行日常交际,而教材的5、6级中增加的阅读课更是有助于增长学生的科学知识,开阔视野。

本套教材取材于日常生活,语言地道、风趣而又实用。此外,课本配有生动活泼的插图,制作精美,色彩明快,可以在视觉上吸引学生的注意力,进一步强化学习效果。本套教材将成为少儿学习英语的良师益友。




