1990年對於北京和中國來說,是一個充满歡樂、充滿活力的興旺年頭。四年一度的亞洲體育盛會——第十一屆亞洲運動會,將在北京隆重開幕。來自亞洲各個國家和地區的體育健兒、記者、旅游者和各國來賓,將雲集北京,參加亞洲歷史上競賽項目最全、人數最多、規模最大的盛大體育節日。本屆亞運會"團結、友誼、進步"的宗旨,將得到充分的體現。

已經舉辦過的十屆亞運會和兩屆冬季亞運會,每屆除體育競賽項目外,還舉辦一些文化藝術活動。活動內容依主辦國情况而異。但是,無論哪屆主辦國,都將一項工作列爲重要日程,並保證按時實現,從未閒斷。這就是專爲亞運會發行紀念郵票。開始一般是開幕時發行,後來有提前數月或一年發行或分組發行,甚至在閉幕日或閉幕之後還在慶祝發行。

亞運會郵票,是體育專題集郵類別中的一支獨具風采的奇葩。各主辦國對郵票的設計、印制、發行工作都非常重視。這些郵票廣泛受到各國運動員、體育愛好者和集郵愛好者的青睐。方寸郵花通過信件傳往世界各地、爲亞運會增姿添彩。亞達會的比賽項目按規定允許東道國酌情增減、因此、歷居亞運會都有一些亞洲地區特有的民族體育項目、如藤球、跆拳道、武術等列入競賽或表演項目,使郵票圖案的內容更爲豐富、更富有地區民族色彩。亞洲的世界名勝,如印度孔雀王朝的獅子柱頭、古天文臺、印度尼西亞的婆羅浮屠、中國的萬里長城以及各種神話故事、名畫、現代體育建築、會徽和吉祥物、都曾出現在亞運會郵票上面。可以說、亞運會郵票是從一個側面反

FOREWORD

1990 is a prosperous year filled with joy and energy for China as a whole and for Beijing in particular, as the long-awaited 11th Asian Games, which is the biggest athletic festival in Asia, meeting once every 4 years, will take place in Beijing. Athletes, visitors, tourists and invited guests from various countries and regions in Asia will assemble in the Chinese capital, participating in the most eventful, most populous and largest-in-scale sports gala in Asian history, during which its theme of "UNITY, FRIENDSHIP, PROGRESS" will be fully manifested.

Up to date, 10 Asian Games and 2 Winter Asian Games have been held. Each time many cultural and artistic activities also take place, aside from athletic events. The activities may vary from country to country. However, all the host countries never fail to do one important thing in common — the issuance of the Asian Games commemorative stamps, and the stamps are ensured to come out in good time. At first, the stamps were released at the Games opening ceremony; but for the more recent Games, the series were issued months or even a year in advance. Sometimes even the Game's closing day or afterward saw the issuance of the related stamps.

The Asian Games issues are specialized welcome items sought after by thematic collectors of stamps about sports. Therefore, all the host countries have been extremely thoughtful and meticulous with the design and printing. The stamps are treasured by the athletes as well as sports enthusiasts and stamp collectors, and have travelled, through mails, to all corners of the world, thus adding splendour to the Asian Games.

The events for the Asian Games are basically identical with those for the Olympic Games. In the mean time, the host countries are entitled to either put in or omit some sportive events. So some special athletic events characteristic of certain Asian nations are also found included in the Games, such as Takraw, Taekwon-Do-Kompfer and Wu Shu (martial art). The contents of the stamps are, therefore, further enriched. Many historical monuments in Asia are depicted on the stamps. The lion-headed pillar of India's Peacock Dynasty, the Ancient Observatory, Indonesia's Borobudur, the Great Wall of China are examples. Similarly, many fairy tales, modern sports facilities,

the Games emblem and mascots have also found their way onto the stamps. It can be well said that the Asian Games stamps are vivid miniatures by and large reflecting the athletic advances in Asia.

To meet the forthcoming 11th Asian Games, we have pooled our efforts together in presenting this pictorial "A COMPLETE COLLECTION OF ASIAN GAMES STAMPS". The volume covers all the commemorative stamps for all the sessions of the Games, the 1st through the 11th, issued by various countries. We have also selectively included most of the related First Day Covers, postcards, cachets, and other relevant materials and photographic records, with the upcoming 11th Asian Games as the focus taking up the lion's share of the volume. It is believed that this volume will offer the readers both at home and abroad, sports fans and stamp collectors in particular, a comprehensive presentation of the history of the Asian Games stamp issues. As a gigantic and well-illustrated reference book, the volume is also our contribution to the promotion of the cultural exchange, friendship and unity between the people of all countries.

We wish to acknowledge our appreciation to The Cultural and Exhibition Department of the Organizing Committee of the 11th Asian Games, the Beijing Yanshan Press, the Beijing Gulou Philatelic Society, for their invaluable cooperation in the editing process. Special thanks also go to the philatelists in this country, and abroad, Tatsuya Abe of Japan, Mr. Tan Kai Hong and Cheng Choo Kwang of Singapore Mr. Kwoak Kab Jin of South Korea, Mr. S.K. Lee of the Philippines, and Mr. Chen Guo Fu and Mr. Li Tang of Hong Kong, Mr. Avter Singh Banga of India who have generously provided part of necessary stamps and literature.

Our heartfelt thanks go to President Sheikh Fahad Al Sabah of the Olympic Council of Asia, who has been so kind as to have sent us the message of congratulations which appears on the previous page.

第一屆亞運會原定於1950年在印度新德里舉行,後因印度國內原因推遲於1951年3月4日至10日召開。從此揭開了亞洲體育運動的新篇章。

長期以來亞洲地區體育落後, 為迅速改變這種狀況, 印度田徑聯合會主席桑迪博士於1948年在倫敦舉行的第十四屆奧運會上, 邀請中國、伊朗、巴基斯坦、菲律賓等 13 國代表舉行會議, 商討組織亞洲體育聯合會的問題。次年, 印度再次邀請部分亞洲國家體育組織開






會,會上正式成立了"亞洲運動會聯合會",1982年改稱"亞洲奧林匹克理事會"(簡稱"亞奧理事會")。由其主辦的亞運會是獲國際奧林匹克委員會正式承認的亞洲地區運動會,每四年舉行一次,時間安排在兩居奧運會中間。

第一屆亞運會設田徑、游泳(包括跳水、水球)、舉重、自行車、籃球、足球6個比賽項目, 11個國家的489名運動員(其中女31名)參加了57枚金牌的角逐。我中華全國體育總會應 邀派出以吴學謙爲團長的代表團參觀了運動會。

印度於 1951年 3月 4日發行了第一套亞運會紀念郵票, 全 2枚, 圖案均為在亞

洲地圖前熊熊燃烧的火炬。火炬 是由印度國徽上獅子柱頭的底座 所構成,而獅子柱頭則是印度摩 竭陀國孔雀王朝的阿育王在婆羅 奈斯城鹿野苑所建,獅座上刻有 法輪及奔跑着的獸類,這是印度 古代文明的象征。














首套非主辦國發行的亞運會郵票及其首日封

兩國發行的亞運會,郵票都以 火炬爲主圖, 象征着體育聖火已 經在貧窮落後的亞洲熊熊燃起。
