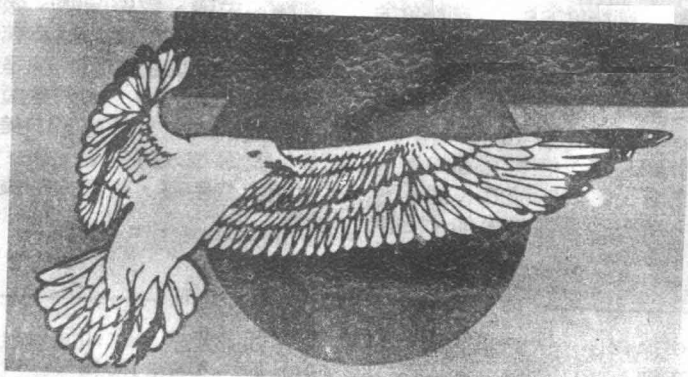

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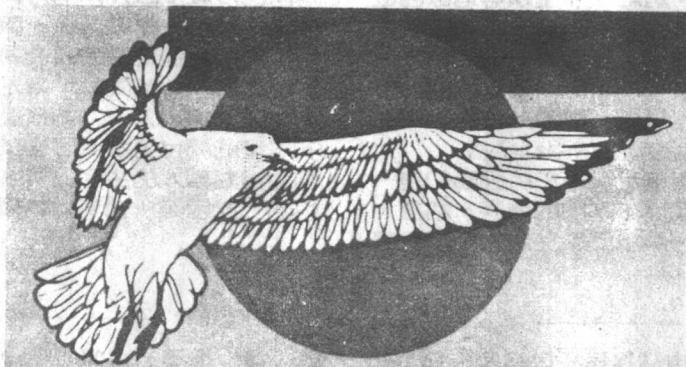


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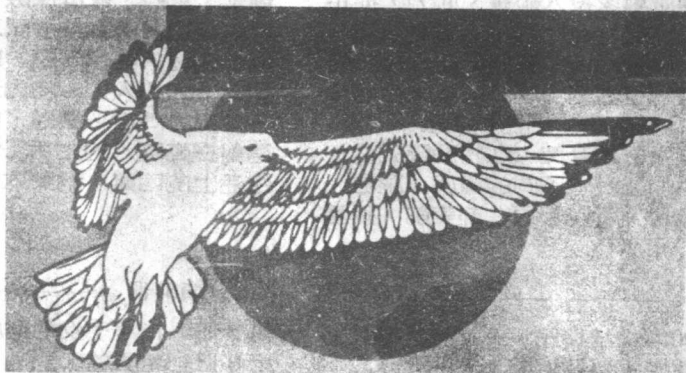

聯邦調查局報告美國的暴力犯罪減少 F.B.I. Reports Violent Crime Receding in the U.S.

According to the F.B.I.'s 1982 annual *Uniform Crime Reports*, the number of serious crimes in the United States reported to the police dropped 3% in 1982, and the over-all crime rate declined 4%, the lowest in six years. Murder was down 7%, robbery 6%, and forcible rape dropped 5%. Burglaries

decreased 9%, motor vehicle theft 2%, and larceny-theft decreased by 1%.

The F.B.I. reported that the number of serious crimes in 1982 was estimated at 12.9 million as compared with 13.3 million in 1983.
