第三轮中等医学教材出版说明

卫生部曾于 1983 年组织编写、陆续出版全国中等卫生学校 11 个专业使用的 77 种教材。1992 年又组织小修订,出版第二轮教材,为我国的中等医学教育作出了积极贡献。

为适应中等医学教育改革形势的需要和医学模式的转变,1993年11月,卫生部审定、颁发了全国中等卫生学校新的教学计划及教学大纲。在卫生部科教司领导下,我们组织编写(修订)出版第三轮全国中等医学12个专业96种规划教材,供各地教学使用。

这轮教材以培养中级实用型卫技人才为目标,以新的教学计划及大纲为依据,体现"思想性、科学性、先进性、启发性、适用性",强调"基本理论知识、基本实践技能、基本态度方法"。教材所用的医学名词、药物、检验项目、计量单位,注意规范化,符合国家要求。

编写教材仍实行主编负责制;编审委员会在教材编审及组织管理中、起参谋、助手、 纽带作用;部分初版教材和新任主编,请主审协助质量把关。第三轮中等医学教材由人 民卫生、河北教育、山东科技、浙江科技、江苏科技、安徽科技、广东科技、四川科技 和陕西科技 9 家出版社出版。

希望各校师生在使用规划教材的过程中,提出宝贵意见,以便教材质量能不断提高。

《全国中等卫生学校教材·英语》(第三版)是由卫生部组织按照卫生部新的《教学计划》和《教学大纲》进行修订(编写)的,供中等卫生学校三年制和四年制各专业英语教学使用。本教材的特点是:基础英语,衔接初中,结合专业,突出实用。旨在培养实用型中等卫生人才,使中等医学校学生在原有的初中英语基础上,进一步进行听、说、读、写的基本训练,为进一步学习英语和阅读本专业有关的英语资料打下初步的基础。几点说明如下:

- 1. 依据《大纲》,全书设 22 个教学单元,由课文、会话和医学应用文三大教学内容组成,按照 228 学时编排,仍分上下两册。上册 (第 1~13 单元)约需 125 学时,为基础英语,各专业必修。下册 (第 14~22 单元)约需 103 学时,为医学英语,供各专业选修,其中第 14~16 单元侧重药剂和检验;第 17~19 单元侧重医疗、伦理和医学史话;第 20~22 单元侧重医学影像和放射技术。在教学中,可根据各专业的教学实际情况取舍或调整。
 - 2. 语音单元主要为复习、归纳初中已学的英语语音知识。起点与初中教材衔接。
- 3. 全书生词约 2 300 (上册约 1 300,下册约 1 000) 个,分别出现于课文和阅读材料中。凡初中已学了的词汇,本书不再列入词汇表。练习中有少量生词 (不超过 3%),主要出现于借助词典阅读的练习题中,由学生自己查阅,培养使用工具书的能力。
- 4. 语法讲授,仍采用"边讲边练"的方法,系统地复习、归纳初中已学的语法知识, 在此基础上深化扩展,完成基础语法教学。
- 5. 坚持寓思想教育和医学教育于英语教学中。课文 40 篇,每篇一般 300 词左右,由 浅入深,以医学科普和医学基础知识的内容为主,语言地道,力求"五性"(思想性、科学性、先进性、启发性和实用性),既为学生打好坚实的语言基础,又激励学生献身医学事业。
- 6. 会话 27 篇,根据《大纲》规定的听、说学时编排,贴近日常生活会话,侧重医药卫生方面的内容,引导学生开展交际,进行听说训练。
- 7. 医学应用文 7 篇,编于读写单元中,项目有书信、护理记录、完整病历、化验和 X 光检查报告、论文标题和摘要、药品和专业仪器说明书等,只作浅易介绍,注重实用。
- 8. 每课均配有词汇、语法和阅读练习。练习题较多,教师可根据教学的实际情况和学生水平选用,有的可作课堂口头练习,有的可作书面作业。但每课的中心是课文,学生应在掌握课文的基础上再做练习,以取得好的效果。

由潘晓静(吉林四平卫校)老师编写,第38课由郭雷老师编写,第39~40课及读写5~7由吴利民老师编写,听说5~7的会话11~27由杨菊媛(贵阳市卫校)老师编写。本书的插图特约黄强绘制。
