#### The History of Money

Today, our currency is a mixture of coins and paper money, but it wasn't always that way. Before metal coins and paper bills existed, people used a lot of unusual things to buy what they needed. In one part of the world, for example, people used sharks teeth for money. In other places, brightly-colored feathers and seashells were money.

No one knows for sure when people started using metal coins for money. Scholars have found coins dating from 600 B. C., so we know they have been around for a long time. At first, people used valuable metals, such as gold and silver to make coins.

In the 1200s, people in China used iron coins for their currency. These coins weren't worth very much, so people had to use a lot of coins for doing business. Because it was too heavy to carry around a large number of iron coins, the government started printing paper money. People took paper money to banks and traded them in for coins. This is the first example we have of paper money.

Today, most countries use a mixture of coins and paper bills for their currency. In the United States, the paper bills are all of the same size and color. For example, the one-dollar bill is the same size and color as the one-hundred-dollar bill. In many other countries, the bills come in various sizes and colors. Usually, the smaller-sized bills are worth less money. This makes it easier for people to tell the value of their money at a glance.
