## 前言

自"大学英语教学大纲"(高等院校理工科本科用) 颁布以来,各高校的英语教师都在努力提高学生的语言这 用能力,以求达到大纲的要求。我们就现行使用的各种教 材和试题,在英语词汇方面作了统计和研究,针对学生词 汇能力比较薄弱的现实,选编了这本《大学英语四级水平 词汇测试集》,旨在使学生经过强化练习,熟练掌握大纲 规定的词汇及其运用,顺利通过大学英语四级水平考试。

我们精选了大纲中的动词、名词、形容词和少量副词, 汇编成32个独立的测试单元,每个单元含50个句子,並附 有参考答案,既可供教师课内外辅导用,又可供学生自学用。

本测试集的内容包括动词一词多义的掌握、同义词或近义词的辨析、相形词的区别及各派生词的应用等等。部分练习在试用过程中得到了学生的普遍好评。
