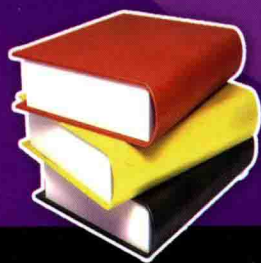

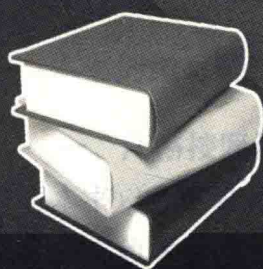

# 前 言

高等学校英语应用能力考试分 A、B 两级，A 级考试为高职高专学生应该达到的标准要求，B 级考试略低于 A 级考试，是过渡性的要求。原“大学英语三级考试”相当于“高等学校英语应用能力 A 级考试”，原“大学英语二级考试”相当于“高等学校英语应用能力 B 级考试”。学校自主决定参加 A 级或 B 级考试。

现有的大学外语考试考点，都可以设“高等学校英语应用能力考试”考点，并组织本校的“三校生”（即高等专科学校学生、高职专科学生、成人高校学生）或艺术、体育类院校的本科生参加“高等学校英语应用能力考试”，但必须在省教育厅和省招考办备案。现未设大学外语考试考点的学校（主要是独立设置的高职学院、成人高等学校），需要向省教育厅高教处申请设置“高等学校英语应用能力考试”考点，经审核批准后，可组织本校学生参加“高等学校英语应用能力考试”。

在高等学校英语应用能力考试竞争日趋激烈的形式下，为了满足广大考生的迫切需求，我们特组织了大量有丰富教学、辅导及培训经验的专家和教授，花费大量时间精心编写了这本《高等学校英语应用能力 A 级考试过关必做 1200 题》。

本书的编写特色如下：

## 一、严格按照最新考试大纲精神，系统、全面、深入

本书以最新考试大纲精神为依据，辅之以大量经典的试题及详细解析，全面提升考生的综合应试能力。
