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## 前 言

《我也能说汉语》是一本应急教材，只要求“听说”，不要求“读写”，所以课文不出现难写难认的汉字。

在“听说”方面，也是初步，即只要求能听、能说最简单的短语和短句。例如商品有很多种，不可能一一记住，只说“这个”、“那个”，对方就知道你要的是什么；再如问价钱也只说“多少钱”，虽然句子不够完整，但对方也能听懂你的意思。短语、短句，易学易记，最受初学者欢迎。

到中国旅游或参加“奥运会”、“世博会”，如果先学一点儿最简单的汉语，到时候就可以跟中国人打招呼。另外，吃饭、问路、买东西，也能说上一两句，这样可以减少在异国的陌生感，增加亲切感，使整个旅途变得十分愉快、十分温馨。

课文短，句子短，生词少，这是本教材的特点。全书共二十课，生词仅121个。每天学两个小时，两个星期就可学完，真可谓快捷实效！

每篇课文都配有卡通图，形象生动，一看就懂。为了便于自学，生词都用国际音标标注；句子则有对应的英文翻译，并附有音像材料。

为了加强听和说的能力，音像材料突出语言的分解和句子的复读，并放慢语速，这样能让学习者听得清、跟得上，一步一个脚印，循序渐进。

本教材可供短训班使用，如有老师指导，学习效果或许会更好。

## Preface



*I Too Can Speak Chinese* is a textbook which may meet the urgent needs of beginners of Chinese. As it only requires the learner to acquire the basics of basics in listening and speaking in Chinese without any attendant requirement on reading and writing, this book does not teach Chinese characters which sometimes may be a little hard to recognize and write for beginning Western learners.

With regard to listening and speaking, this book only requires learners to understand and speak some very useful simple phrases and short sentences. For example, there are a huge variety of useful things each with its own name and one cannot learn them all at the same time, but if s/he knows how to say "this one" or "that one" in Chinese, the person addressed will know what s/he means. When s/he wants to ask about the price of something, saying only "How much?" will do for her/his purpose. As phrases and short sentences are easy to learn and memorize, this book will be very useful for beginning learners of Chinese.

When a foreigner who has learned some simple Chinese comes to China for sightseeing or to attend the Olympic Games or Expo2010, s/he may greet her/his friendly Chinese hosts with what s/he has learned and say some simple Chinese when dining at a restaurant, asking the way or doing shopping. By doing this, his stay in China will become more interesting and pleasant and the feeling of being a stranger may vanish or

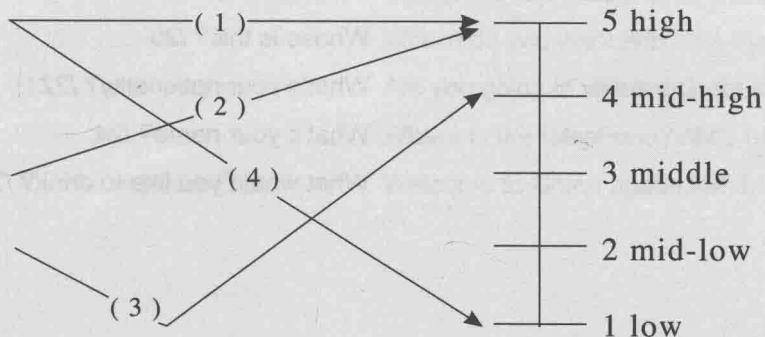

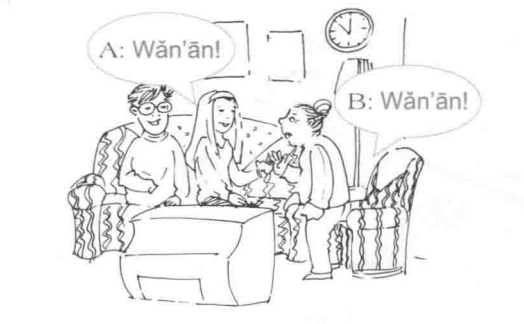
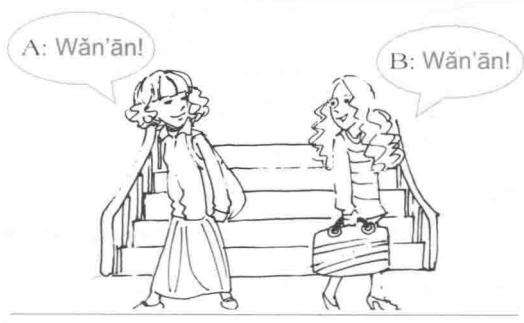
