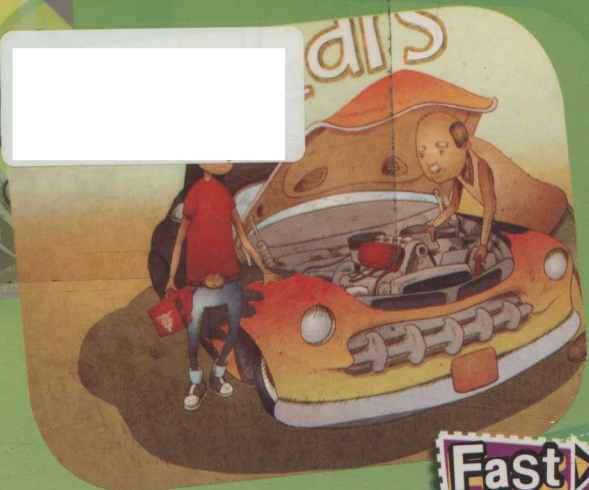

出版前言

Then, everything went quiet. Trent got out and looked around. The place was a mess (凌乱状态). Dr Holland was gone.



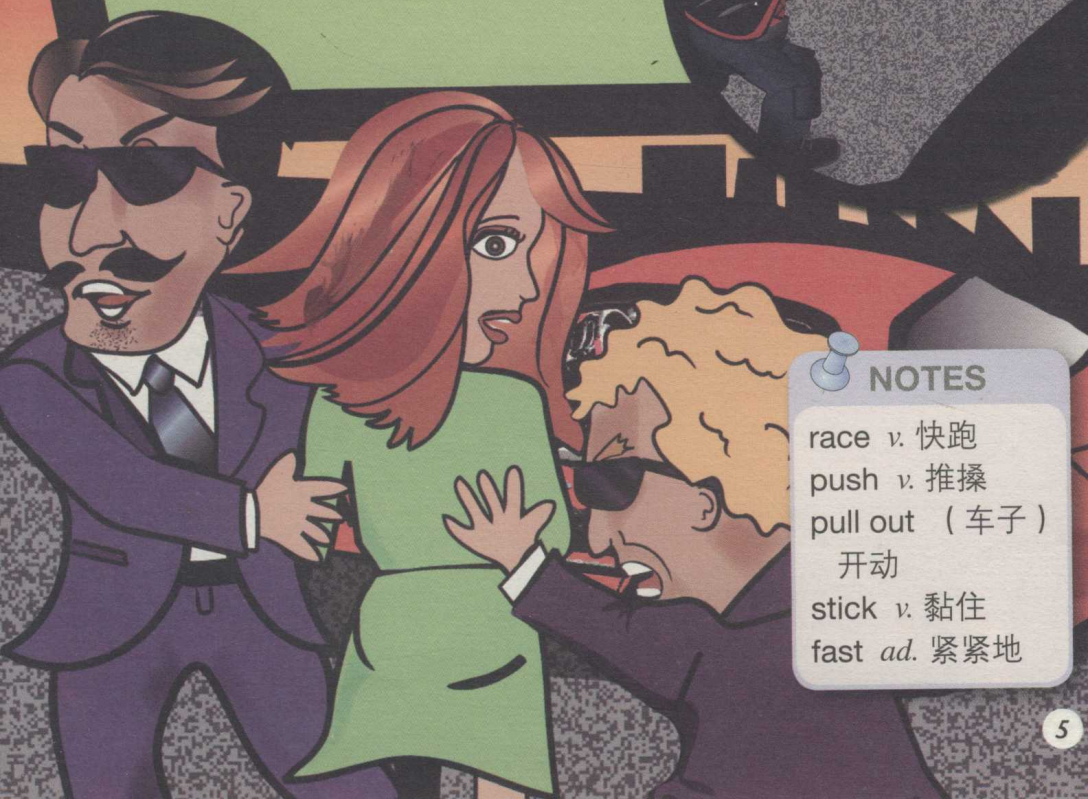

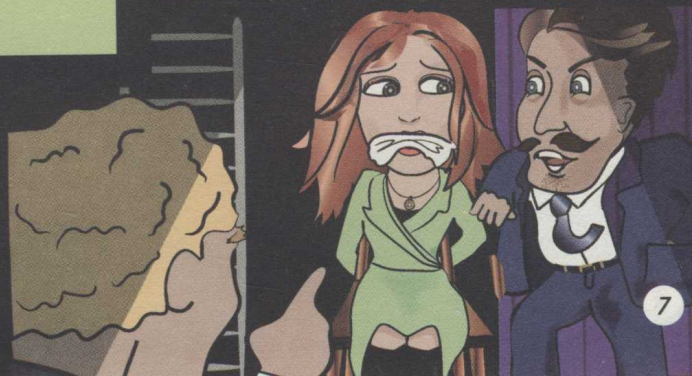
Trent found the car parked outside an old warehouse (仓库). He got off his super skateboard and crept (悄悄地行进) around the back.

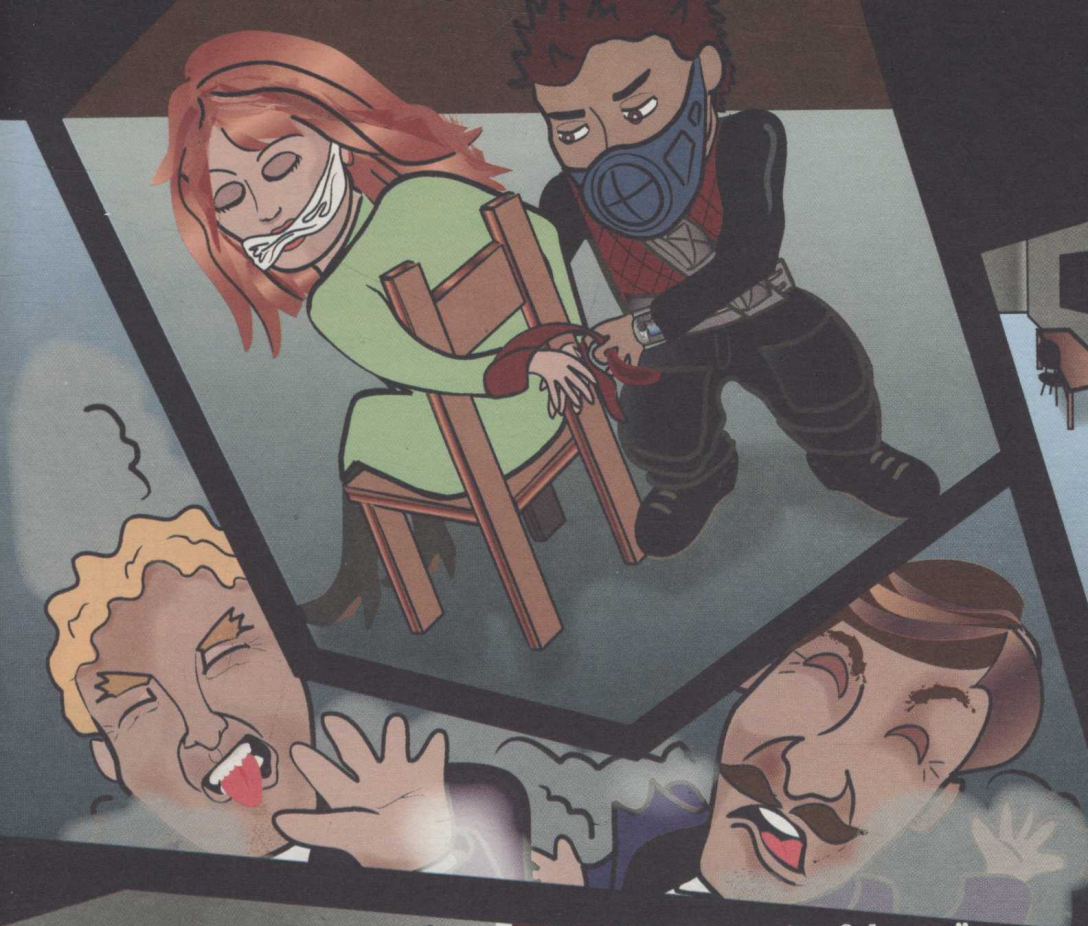

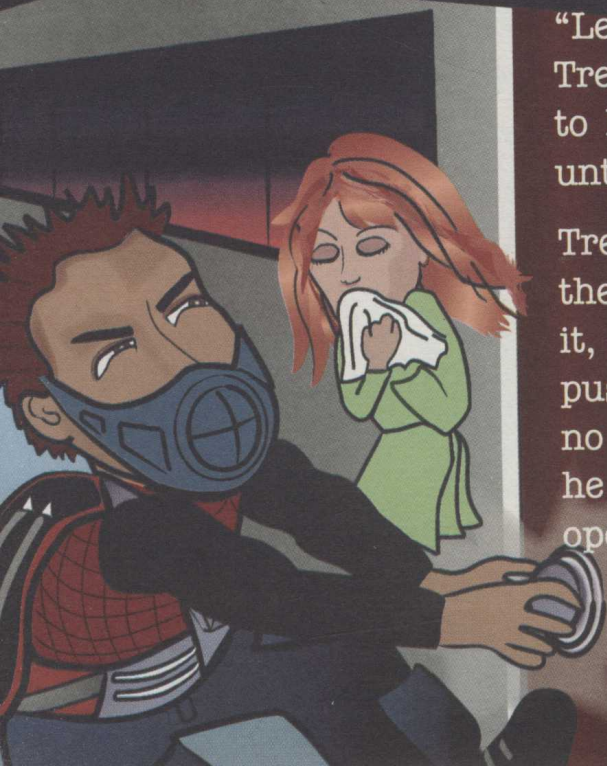
