#### 易错点剖析

#### 1. 由于基础知识不扎实而误选

由于种种原因,考生对知识点掌握不够扎实,导致在选择时对语言知识混淆不清,结果造成错选。这种错误原因占了易错原因的很大比例。

#### 2. 受思维定势影响,缺少良好的思维习惯而误选

思维定势对考生造成的负面影响主要有:只注意了知识的普遍性,而忽略了其特殊性。只注意了试题的表面,而忽略了题中已经变化的条件或情境。考生会因为这些原因轻率地选出"正确答案"导致错误。

#### 3. 缺乏对词义和句子的深入理解

近年来,命题者开始逐渐淡化语法知识,趋向于考查学生运用语言的能力,即考查考生在一定情景下正确使用语言知识的能力。它要求考生必须理解句子所提供的情景,如对话的时间、场合、人物的关系等,才能选择正确的答案。


