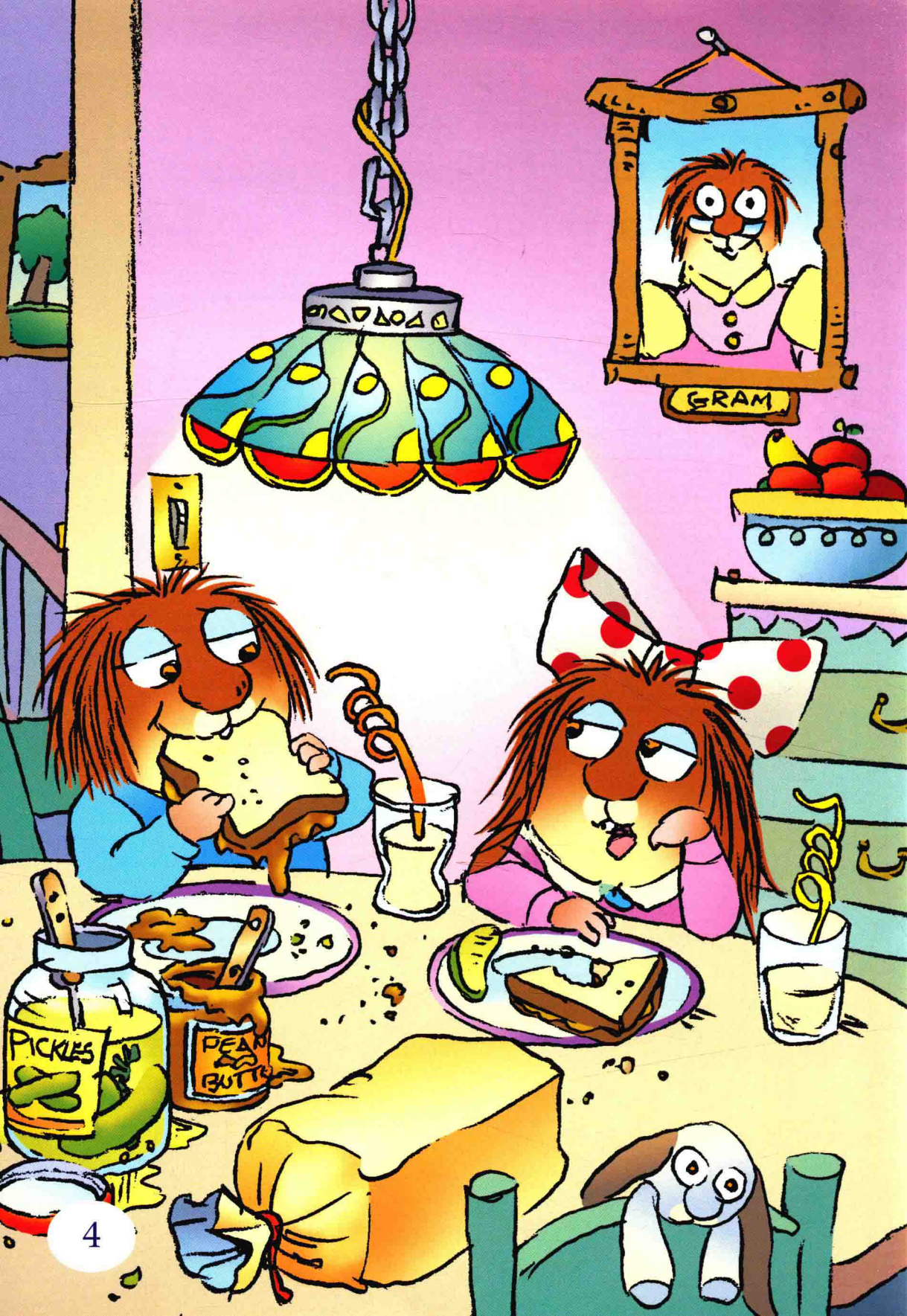


THE MUMMY

“I’m still not sleepy,” she said.



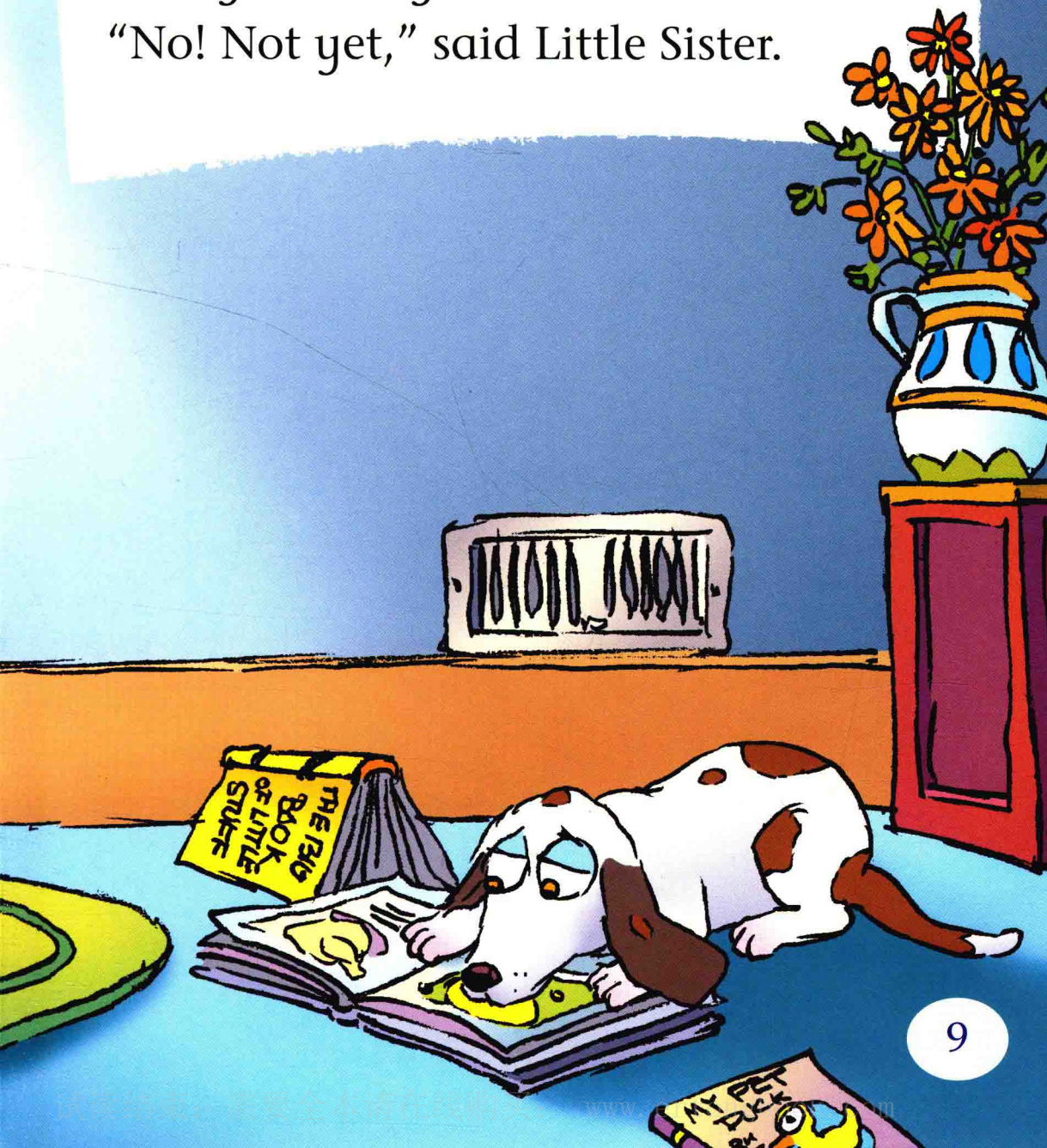




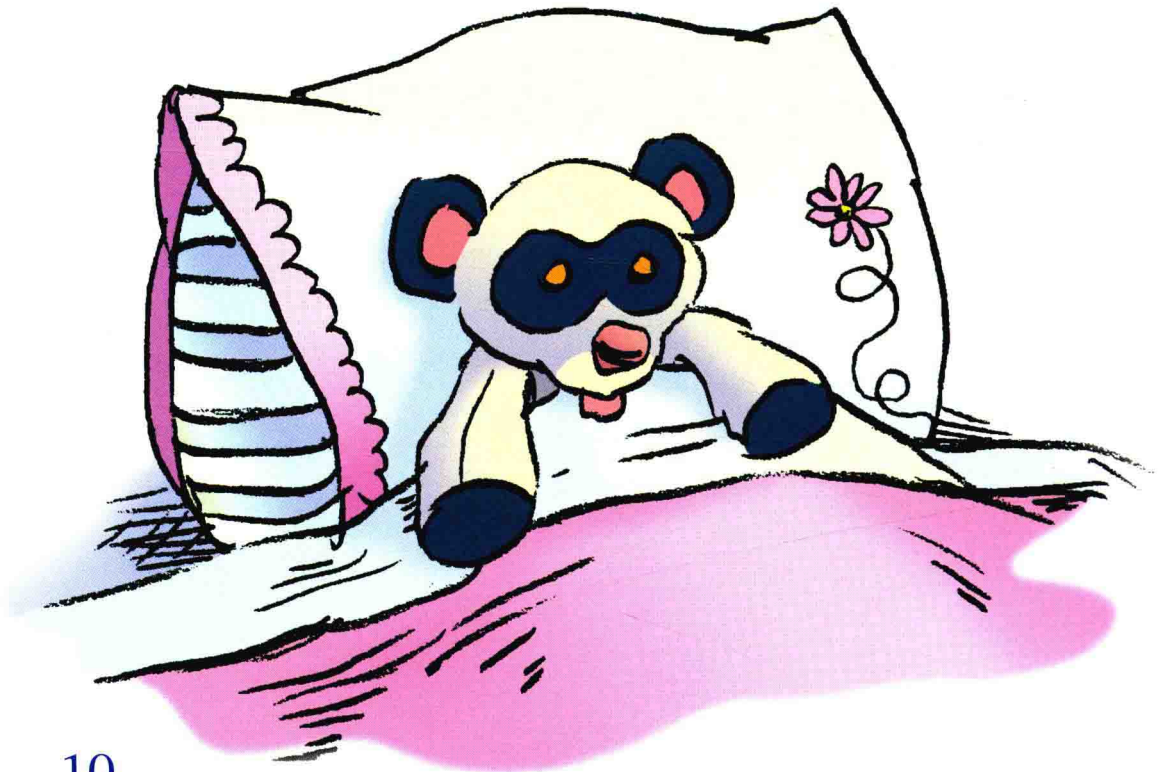
“A story will make you sleepy,” I said.

“No! Not yet,” said Little Sister.



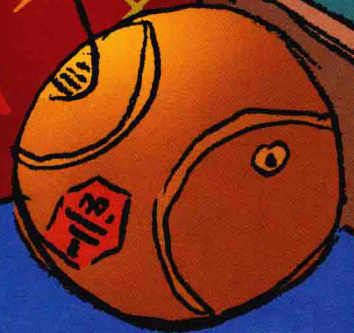
“Maybe your teddy bear is getting lonely,” I said.

I did not have to stay very long.



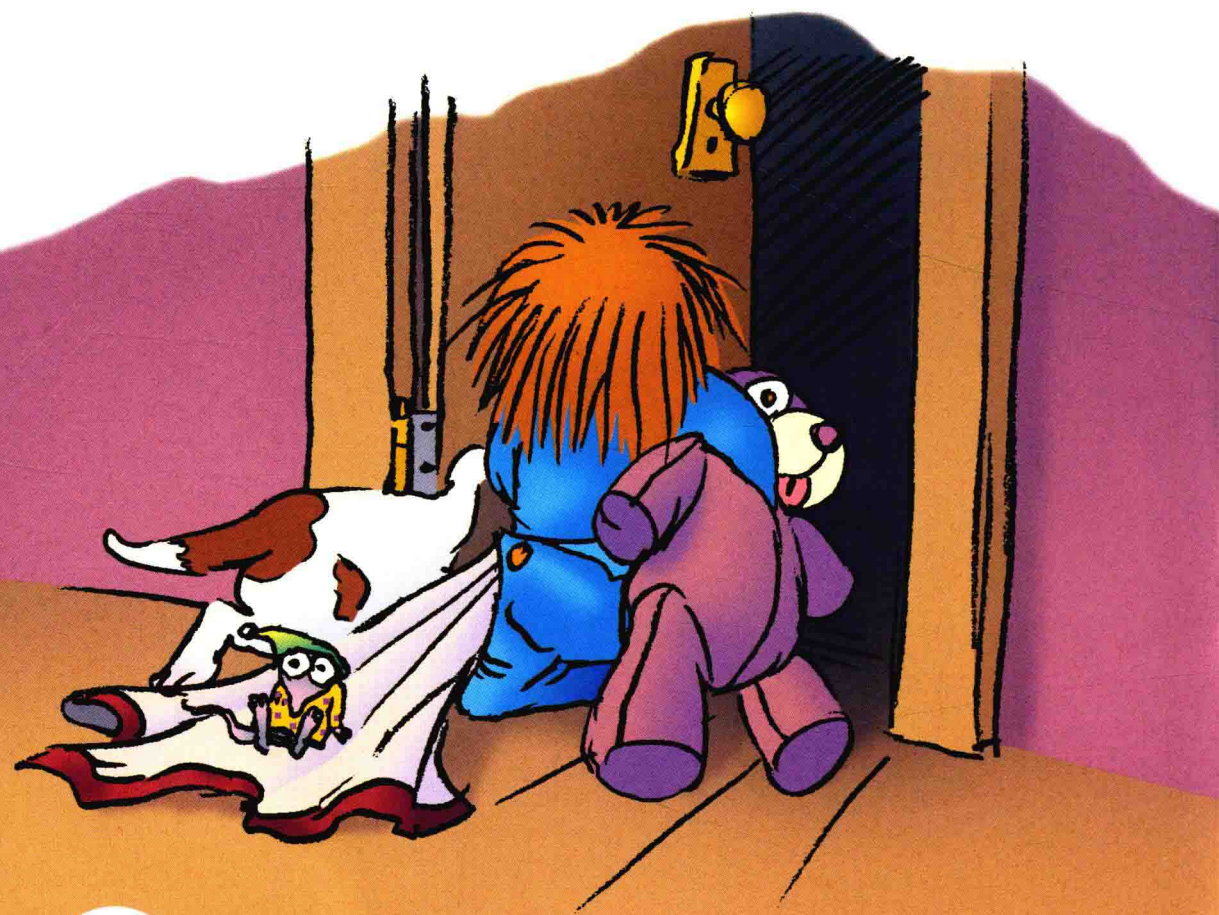


I went back to my own room.
