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## 作者简介

韦金笙，1936年生，上海市人。曾任扬州市园林管理局总工程师、高级工程师、中国风景园林学会花卉盆景赏石分会副理事长，现任中国风景园林学会花卉盆景赏石分会顾问。

作者从事风景园林、花卉盆景研究和建设五十余载。曾系统研究扬派盆景个性，发扬“云片”特色，主张打破“师传口授”习俗，总结扬派盆景技艺11种棕法。倡导继承传统，并在继承传统的基础上进行创新。1979年10月主持在北京举办的全国“盆景艺术展览”在苏北馆展出，重点展览扬派盆景并获好评。翌年，参加《中国盆景艺术的研究》国家科研项目，并于1981年9月成功确立扬派盆景为中国盆景五大流派之一。1984年10月主持筹建扬州盆景园。1986年5月主持规划、设计并参与施工在意大利举办的第五届国际花卉博览会的中国盆景馆，荣获最佳布置荣誉银质奖。1995年5月，任中国代表团秘书长，参加在新加坡举办的“第三届亚太地区盆景赏石会议暨展览会”，首场讲演《中国盆景的历史、流派及其艺术欣赏意境》。1997年10月，担任在上海举办的“第四届亚太地区盆景赏石会议暨展览会”执行副主席，主持盆景展览、盆景研讨会，并担任评委。1999年5月，担任“中国’99昆明世界园艺博览会”专业评审组专家，主持盆景评比。曾代表分会与主办城市共同主持第三、四、五、六届“中国盆景(评比)展览会”，并任主评委。2001年5月，建设部城建司、中国风景园林学会为表彰其为中国盆景事业作出的突出贡献，特为其颁发“突出贡献奖”。2005年9月担任在北京举办的“第八届亚太地区盆景赏石会议暨展览会”组委会成员，主持中国(台湾)盆景艺术大师创作示范表演。2007年9月，应邀参加在印尼亚厘岛举办的“第九届亚太地区盆景赏石会议暨展览会”，并任盆景评审。2009年10月，应邀参加在中国台湾彰化举办的“第十届亚太地区盆景赏石会议暨展览会”，并任盆景评审。

编著的图书有《中国扬派盆景》、《韦金笙论中国盆景艺术》(2004年)；主编的图书有《中国盆景艺术大观》(1998年)、《中国当代盆景精粹》(2001年)、《中国盆景流派丛书》(2004年)、《中国盆景名园藏品集》(2005年)、《中国古盆鉴赏》(2006年)、《中国盆景风格丛书》(2008年)、《中国盆景制作技术手册》(2011年)。

## About the Author

Wei Jinsheng, born in Shanghai in 1936, former chief engineer and senior engineer of Yangzhou Landscape Administration Bureau, former deputy chairman of Stone Appreciation Branch of China Landscape Society, is now councilor of Pot Tree and Stone Appreciation Branch of China Landscape Society.

The author has been engaged in the study and development of landscape and pot plants for more than 50 years. He once conducted systematic researches into the individuality of Yangzhou pot plants and landscape art and generalized 11 binding methods in making Yangzhou pot plants, promoting “Cloud-style” of potted trees and advocating giving up “the word of mouth method from masters to apprentices.” He is a supporter of inheriting traditions and innovating on the basis of that. In October, 1979, he presided in Beijing over the exhibition of North Jiangsu Hall at the national “Exhibition of Pot Plants and Miniature Landscape”, laying emphasis on the pot plants and miniature landscape of Yangzhou School which won him favorable comments. The following year, he participated in the national scientific research program “Studies of China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art” and in September of 1981, Yangzhou School of pot plant and miniature landscape art was successfully established as one of the five China’s major schools. In October, 1984, he presided over the building of the Yangzhou Garden of Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art. In May, 1986, he presided over the plan and design of and took part in the building of China’s Exhibition Hall at the Fifth International Horticulture Exposition in Italy and won an honorary silver medal for best layout. In May, 1995, he, as the general secretary of Chinese delegation, attended The 3rd Conference & Exhibition of Pot Plant, Miniature Landscape and Stone Art of Asian and Pacific Areas held in Singapore and delivered at the conference the first speech *The History, Schools and Artistic Conceptions of China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art*. In October, 1997, as the executive vice chairman of The 4th Conference & Exhibition of Pot Plant, Miniature Landscape and Stone Art of Asian and Pacific Areas, he presided over the exhibition and the symposium and acted as a judge. In May, 1999, he was invited to China’s ‘99 Kunming International Horticulture Exposition as an expert of the professional jury and presided over the appraisal of the artistic works. In the 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th “National Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art Exhibition (competition)”, he presided over the events with the host cities on behalf of Stone Appreciation Branch of China Landscape Society and acted as the chief judge. In May, 2001, the

Urban and Rural Development Department of the Ministry of Construction together with China Landscape Society awarded him “Prize of Prominent Contribution” for his outstanding work in the development of China’s pot plant and miniature landscape art. In September, 2005, he served as a member of the organizing committee in The 8th Conference & Exhibition of Pot Plant, Miniature Landscape and Stone Art of Asian and Pacific Areas held in Beijing and presided over the demonstration performed by Chinese (Taiwan) master artists. In September, 2007, he was invited to attend The 9th Conference & Exhibition of Pot Plant, Miniature Landscape and Stone Art of Asian and Pacific Areas held in Bali, Indonesia and acted as a judge of pot plants. In October, 2009, he was invited to attend The 10th Conference & Exhibition of Pot Plant, Miniature Landscape and Stone Art of Asian and Pacific Areas held in Zhanghua, Taiwan, China and served as a judge of pot plants.

He is the author of *China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art of Yangzhou School* and *Wei Jinsheng on China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art* (2004); chief compiler of *Panorama of China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art* (1998), *Highlights of China’s Contemporary Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art* (2001), *Series of the Art Schools of China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art* (2004), *Collected Masterpieces in Famous Gardens of China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art* (2005), *Appreciation of Ancient China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art* (2006), *Series of China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art Styles* (2008) and *A handbook of Skills in Creating China’s Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Works* (2011).

# 前言

扬派盆景，经明代开创风格，被承认、欣赏；清代广泛流传，形成流派；并于新中国成立后继承传统，并发扬个性。1981年9月24日，在由国家城市建设总局科研教育设计局、园林绿化局审定的《中国盆景艺术的研究》科研成果中，扬派盆景被确认为中国盆景五大流派之一，成为中国盆景艺术的重要流派。继后，扬派盆景参加第一届至第五届中国盆景评比展览，黄杨盆景《巧云》《腾云》《行云》《凌云》《碧云》《彩云》等作品先后荣获历届展览一等奖，实现五连冠。其中，黄杨盆景《腾云》1990年还荣获“日本大阪花与绿国际花卉博览会”金奖；黄杨盆景《碧云》1999年荣获“中国‘99昆明世界园艺博览会”金奖，使扬派盆景盛誉海内外。

2008年6月，扬派盆景技艺被国务院公布并列入国家级非物质文化遗产名录。

在继承传统的同时，扬州专业盆景工作者、业余盆景爱好者也与时俱进，在继承传统的基础上创新水旱盆景，其中水旱盆景《古木清池》于1999年荣获“中国‘99昆明世界园艺博览会”大奖。同时发展写意树木盆景，其中雀梅盆景《古木情深》1997年荣获“第四届中国盆景评比展览”一等奖。除此之外，还有山水盆景，其中山水盆景《雨沐春山》1997年荣获“第四届中国盆景评比展览”一等奖。在他们的努力下发展形成多元的扬州盆景艺术，为发展中国盆景艺术做出新的贡献。

《扬州盆景艺术》全面总结、解析、实录，以继承传统，并在继承传统基础上进行创新视觉，论述传统的扬派盆景、创新的水旱盆景、发展的写意树木盆景和山水盆景的艺术特色、创作技艺要领以及佳作赏析，以供广大读者参考、借鉴。

# Preface

The style of the pot plant and miniature landscape art of Yangzhou school, was initiated, recognized and appreciated in the Ming Dynasty. In the Qing Dynasty the art school was formed and became popular, with its tradition and uniqueness inherited and promoted after the founding of the People's Republic of China. On September 24, 1981, Yangzhou Art School was named one of the five major pot plant and miniature landscape art schools in China after the examination and approval of the scientific research achievements—*Researches into Chinese Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art*—conducted by the Bureau of Scientific Research, Education and Design, General Administration of Urban Development of China and the Bureau of Landscape and Forestry. Since that, Yangzhou School has been an important school in China's pot plant and miniature landscape art. After that, Yangzhou pot plant and miniature landscapes entered the five (from the first to the fifth) national pot plant and miniature landscape art exhibitions and its potted boxwood "Delicate Cloud", "Jumping Cloud", "Moving Cloud", "Flying Cloud", "Blue Cloud", "Colored Cloud" etc. won the first prize in all the five exhibitions, pocketing five champions in a row. In 1990, its potted boxwood "Jumping Cloud" won the gold medal in Osaka International Flora and Green Exposition and in 1999, and its potted boxwood "Blue Cloud" won the gold medal in China's '99 Kunming International Horticulture Exposition, which earned Yangzhou School a great fame at home and abroad.

In June, 2008, the State Council made public a list of national nonmaterial cultural heritage and the artistic skill of Yangzhou School was included in it.

Not only has Yangzhou inherited the tradition, it has also conducted creative work on the basis of the tradition. The pot plant and miniature landscape artists in Yangzhou, professionals and amateurs, keep pace with the times and have come up with water-and-land miniature landscapes, one of which, "Ancient Trees in Crystal-clear Water" won the top prize in China's '99 Kunming International Horticulture Exposition. At the same time, Yangzhou School artists have used impressionistic method to create pot plants. In 1997, the sparrow plum potted landscape "Deep feelings of the Ancient Tree" won a first prize in The Fourth National Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art Competition Exhibition. In the meantime, potted water and mountain landscapes were in development. In 1997, "Mountain Spring in Rain", a pot of miniature land, won a first prize

in "The Fourth National of Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art Competition Exhibition. Yangzhou School, with concerted efforts and diversity, has made new contributions to China's pot plant and miniature landscape art.

The book *Yangzhou Pot Plant and Miniature Landscape Art* has made a factual record, objective analysis and comprehensive summary of the art of Yangzhou School, displaying its innovative vision on the basis of the tradition and exhibiting the artistic features of the traditional Yangzhou art, innovative water-and-land miniature landscapes, pot plants and miniature landscape art with the impressionistic style. The purpose of presenting the beautiful works, their appreciation and the skills in the process of creation is to provide reference and information for readers.
