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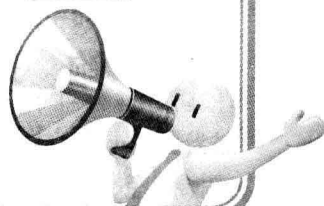

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前言

《基础实用英语》(Essential and Practical College English) 是为少数民族地区高校学生编写的大学英语学习教材。在教材的设计和编写上严格按照《大学英语课程教学要求》，并结合少数民族地区学生的实际英语水平，以打好英语基础和提高语言应用能力为最终目的，全力以赴，打造我国富有民族特色的新型大学英语教材。

本套教材在编写过程中，吸取了我国在外语教学中长期积累下来的行之有效的经验和方法，仔细研究和分析了我国少数民族学生在英语学习中经常遇到的问题及教师在教学过程中的困惑，在教材的编写理念和教学模式上不断创新，充分反映了当今外语教育研究的最新成果。

全套教材由《基础实用英语读写教程》(1~4册)和《基础实用英语听说教程》(1~4册)构成，每册设有八个单元，并配有详尽的教师用书和教学课件。教材内容以单元话题为主线，涉及现代技术、道德情感、文化知识、科学教育等多个方面。语言素材真实、地道，选材广泛，文章短小精悍，具有知识性、趣味性和实用性的鲜明特点。

本套教材起点为大学英语预备级和高职高专新生的入学水平。教学安排上，可分四个学期使用，也可以根据各学校的具体教学情况及学生的专业特点自行安排。教学总时数为220学时，每周安排3~4学时。

本套教材由马占祥教授担任总主编，参加编写的院校有：内蒙古师范大学、内蒙古农业大学职业技术学院、内蒙古兴安盟职业技术学院、锡林郭勒职业学院、呼伦贝尔学院、内蒙古大学鄂尔多斯学院、呼和浩特民族学院和集宁师范学院。

Script:

Spring Festival Travel Rush to Start on January 11th

The Chinese Ministry of Railways says the 2009 Spring Festival travel season will be from January 11th to February 25th.

Wang Yongping, spokesman of the ministry, said on Monday that the 40-day travel season will span the Chinese Lunar New Year, which falls on January 26th, and the Lantern Festival on February 9th.

He said the overall passenger flow is expected to hit 188 million, up 8% year on year. And the average passenger flow is expected to be 4.7 million every day, 340,000 more than the same period in 2008.

During the Spring Festival travel season of 2009, flows of college students, migrant workers and travelers will overlap before the Lunar New Year, making the passenger peak come early. After the Spring Festival, migrant workers may travel back a little bit earlier. But the whole situation of passenger flow is still unclear, given that college students may travel back in the end of the travel season because the new semester begins later.

During the travel rush, the railway department will put into use 319 pairs of additional nonstop passenger trains. It has also prepared three operating schemes to deal with regular, peak and sudden passenger flows.

Script:

People enjoy taking trips because they want to broaden their horizons, learn about other people and other places.

Generally speaking, they are very curious about other cultures. When traveling, they get a quick look at different ways of living.

On a trip, a person can learn directly by visiting museums and historical spots. When a tourist visits the historical palaces and other scenic spots in Paris, he gets a vivid picture—a real life of the French people. He learns about their attitudes, how they feel about business, beauty and history.

What about the tourist who goes to Hong Kong? He might read about the fact from a book that Hong Kong is very crowded, and that there is less than 200 square meters of space for each person, but seeing and feeling the lack of space will impress him much more. He might read about the fact that there are nearly 200 vehicles for every kilometer of roadway, but the sight of so many vehicles parked along the roadside will be a much more vivid lesson. The tourist to Hong Kong will never forget the contrasts—the straight vertical lines of tall modern buildings and the moving lines of boats that people live in.
