前 言

语音在交际过程中起着重要作用,能说一口地道的英语是很多人的梦想,也是传情达意、顺畅交流的必备条件。笔者通过对近三年毕业生的问卷调查了解到,英语语音作为一项重要的专业技能,在培养综合素质、满足就业需求以及提高工作效率上起着非常重要的作用,越来越受到学生的重视。但许多英语学习者不能准确掌握音标的标准书写方式和发音技巧,分不清连读、弱读,甚至听不懂句义,不了解口语的评分标准。所有这些都给口语的学习、应试和日常交流带来了很大困难。

在中国普遍缺乏英语语言环境的背景下,选择适当的学习材料就显得尤为重要。为了满足广大英语学习者的需要,笔者以自身多年的一线教学经验为基础,针对我国读者的学习心理和发音特征,组织精干力量细致策划、反复研讨、群策群力、精诚合作,精心编写了您手中的这本书。

本书与国内已出版的同类书相比较, 具有如下特色:

第一,科学编排,结构合理

本书遵循英语学习者的学习规律编写而成,内容由易到难,循序渐进。 全书共分为十一章,每节分为专题讲解、实践练习和休闲一刻三个模块。具体如下:第一章和第二章采用图解的方式详细讲解了单元音 (包括前元音、后元音、中元音)、双元音和辅音共 48 个音素的发音方法和发音规则,并配有多种形式的练习;第三章精心准备了音素综合辨音测试,配备了大量的针对性练习,对前两章的知识点做了全面的梳理,让读者进一步熟悉、巩固、掌握发音技巧;第四章重点讲解了音节和重音的定义、拼读规律和划分规则;第五章详细阐述了强读和弱读的读音规律、单词读音的变化、对听说的影响、 弱读和强读的对照形式;第六章分析了连读和意群的划分技巧;第七章介绍 了英语节奏的特点,教授掌握英语节奏的技巧和节奏模式;第八章着重讲述 了语调(包括升调和降调)出现的各种情况和用法;第九章对比了英音和美 音中元音和辅音的语音差异和语调差异;第十章介绍了英语专业语音达标要 求、专业四级和八级口语语音要求、评分标准,并附真题范例;第十一章在 前几章讲解的基础上延伸介绍了绕口令、诗歌、美文、演讲和歌曲的欣赏和 朗诵技巧,既有不同文体掌握要领介绍又有针对性的练习和经典美文赏析。 这种编排方式给读者展示了一个异彩纷呈的英语世界。

第二,经典权威,实用高效

本书严格按照教育部高等教育司最新颁布的《高等学校英语专业语音教学大纲要求》编写,以突出其权威性。笔者在编写过程中参考了国内外各类语音出版物,并结合了自己多年的教学经验积累,同时专业口语考试部分由多年来从事口语辅导,并参加全国口语评分的老师编写,使本书内容具有较高的权威性和可靠性。

为了便于教师的课堂教学和读者自学,本书配有光盘,这张光盘是上好的默写和听力材料,读者可以边听、边读、边写,一书多用,全面训练。更值得一提的是,笔者将自身多年的教学经验融入了本书的编写过程,重点攻克读者语音的薄弱环节,并设计有针对性的练习。为了实现语音讲解和口语考试的完美结合,除了语音知识以外,本书还特意安排了专业英语四级、八级口语考试语音要求介绍和近几年真题汇总,以便于读者检验自己的语音水平。另外,本书附录列出了新旧音标的对比,解决了读者辨音的困惑。相信读者一书在手,会听、会说、会读、会写,全无忧。

第三,选材广泛,趣味性强

为了让读者在学习语音知识的同时能够获得快乐的阅读体验,笔者在练习选材的多样性、趣味性和新颖性上下足了功夫。本书的练习和美文欣赏内容是笔者在教学过程中根据学生的喜好搜集整理而成,注重选取当前社会热点话题、校园流行文化、情感励志、商贸活动等话题,选材来自于BBC、VOA、CCTV等权威广播电视栏目的英语文章,使学生在广阔的英语知识天地中学到得心应手的口语。休闲一刻除了选取传统经典诗歌、音乐以外,还把

绕口令、笑话、流行的甄嬛体、虎妈育儿争议、美剧《老友记》、2012 年伦敦奥运会开幕式、奥运会游泳"双料"冠军孙杨的新闻等新鲜内容编入书中,读者不但能学习地道发音,提升英语的听说能力,还能得到家庭、事业和人生的智慧启迪,本书真正做到了与时俱进,寓教于乐。

第四,版式活泼,图文并茂

为了使版式活泼新颖,笔者花费大量的时间精心挑选了应景图片,既有人物、风景图片也有幽默卡通图片,相信会带给读者一种扑面而来的清新的视觉享受,让读者在轻松愉快的氛围中快速掌握地道的英语语音技巧。

本书第一、二章由张思撰写,第三、九、十章由李宁撰写,第四、五、七章由杨东英撰写,第六章由刘宇撰写,第八章由秦学锋编写,第十一章由杨东益撰写。本书在编写过程中得到了许多同事和朋友的大力支持,同时得到了中国书籍出版社领导和编辑的悉心指导,在此表示诚挚的感谢。

本书可作为高等学校英语语音本科教材,也可以作为出国留学人员、旅游者、求职者和广大英语爱好者的语音自学材料,本书能让读者真正实现侃侃而谈讲英语的梦想。

由于编写时间仓促,本书难免存在不足,衷心希望广大读者斧正。



Chapter 1 Vowels 元音



In English, vowels include monophthongs and diphthongs. Monophthongs consist of front vowels (/iː/, /ɪ/, /e/, /æ/), back vowels (/ɑː/, /ɒ/, /ɔː/, /ʊ/, /uː/) and central vowels (/ʌ/, /ɜː/, /ə/). Diphthongs include /eɪ/, /aɪ/, /ɔɪ/, /əu/, /au/, /ɪə/, /eə/ and /əu/. 英语中元音包括单元音和双元音。单元音包含前元音 (/iː/, /ɪ/, /e/, /æ/), 后元音 (/ɑː/, /ɒ/, /ɔː/, /u/, /uː/) 以及中元音 (/ʌ/, /ɜː/, /ə/)。双元音包括/eɪ/, /aɪ/, /ɔɪ/, /əu/, /au/, /ɪə/, /eə/, /əu/。

Section A Monophthongs 单元音

In English, there are twelve monophthongs. Our lips, tongue and jaw do not move while uttering them. According to the position of the tongue, monophthongs can be divided into front vowels (/iː/, /ɪ/, /e/, /æ/), back Vowels (/ɑː/, /ɒ/, /ɔː/, /ʊ/, /uː/) and central vowels (/ʌ/, /ɜː/, /ə/). 英语中共有 12 个单元音。发单元音时,我们的唇、舌和下颌不动。根据舌位的不同,单元音可划分为前元音 (/iː/, /ɪ/, /e/, /æ/), 后元音 (/ɑː/, /ɒ/, /ɔː/, /ʊ/, /uː/) 和中元音 (/ʌ/, /ɜː/, /ə/)。

一、Front Vowels 前元音


Front vowels (/iː/, /ɪ/, /e/, /æ/) have the following features: the tip of the tongue is pressed against the lower teeth; the front part of the tongue is higher than the rest of the tongue; the lips are unrounded; lips are spread or kept neutral. 前元音 (/iː/, /l/, /e/, /æ/) 发音时有以下特征: 舌尖抵下齿,舌前部高于舌其他部分,唇形为扁唇或中唇。

(—) Front Vowel: /iː/

1. Description

Open your mouth a little. The front of the tongue nearly touches the front part of the hard palate, and the muscles of the tongue and cheeks are tense. The lips are spread a little and are drawn back and show a "smiling" face and then a long voiced





sound is produced. 嘴稍张开, 舌前部尽量向硬腭抬起, 舌部和面颊的肌肉较 紧张。唇稍扁平并向后拉伸,露出微笑的表情,声音尽量拉长,声带振动。
