## 内 容 简 介

本册教材供小学六年级第一学期使用。全书共分5个单元,每单元7课,全书共35课。其中,每单元的第7课是复习课,以有趣的教学活动复习巩固本单元所学主要内容。本书旨在使小学生在轻松愉快、生动活泼的教学活动中,学会用英语说自己想说的话,用英语写自己想表达的思想。

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# 出版说明

为迎接 21 世纪的挑战,使中国在国际舞台上充分发挥作用,提高中小学英语教学水平是一项十分迫切的任务。但是,我国目前的英语教学现状远远不能满足要求,这已经引起了有关部门领导和社会各界的广泛关注。清华大学在实施面向 21 世纪的英语教学改革中深深体会到,英语教学必须从源头抓起,从提高中、小学英语教学水平入手。在清华大学教务处的领导下,由清华大学外语系、清华大学附属中学、小学、清华大学出版社联合进行了“大、中、小学英语教学一条龙”教学改革,认真研究并吸收各种外语教育教学理论和方法的优点,广泛进行教学实验。在此基础上,制定一套科学完整的教学大纲,建立一套完整的现代化教材体系和测试体系,探索适合我国国情的、高效的英语教学途径与管理模式。

《小学英语》是该项目的一个研究成果。它根据“级”编写,从 1A, 1B 到 6A, 6B, 共 6 级 12 册。起始年级为 1A, 1B。该教材的前 4 级(1A~4B)完成教育部所制定的《国家英语课程标准》中对小学阶段英语的基本要求。该教材的 5 级, 6 级(5A~6B)为小学英语的进一步巩固和扩展部分。达到 4 级、6 级的学生,词汇量分别达到 900, 1200 以上,并且在听、说方面有重大突破。

本套教材力求体现新的教育思想、新的语言观和外语学习观,突出语言的交际能力及其工具性特点,以发展语言实践能力为主线,以培养学生用英语进行交际的能力为最终目的,同时注意学习兴趣的培养。教学内容由浅入深,循序渐进,重点突出,难点分散。生词分布适当,合理重复,并根据学生的身心特点、认知水平和语言能力选择、编排语言材料。教材体系还注意体现对听、说、读、写的严格训练和对综合运用语言能力的培养。

本套教材采用限定结构和情景教学相结合的编排体系,选择词频高、与儿童生活密切的词汇和句型,把话题、语言结构和语言情景有机地融合起来,并分成三个阶段。第一阶段(1 级、2 级/1A~2B)为语音语调输入阶段,教学宗旨是“听说为主”,着重培养语感,激发学习兴趣。第二阶段(3 级、4 级/3A~4B)为语音语调输入和拼写阶段,教学宗旨是“继续听说,认读跟上”,在继续培养语感和激发兴趣的基础上,开始适当的拼写训练。第三阶段(5 级、6 级/5A~6B)为语音语调输入和听说读写并行阶段,教学宗旨是“听、说、读、写”全面发展。

该教材的研究与实践,是在清华大学“大、中、小学英语教学一条龙”项目领导小组的领导下,在专家顾问委员会的指导下,在全体小学英语教材编写委员会委员的共同努力下进行的。本册由英语语言专家 Tom Kellie, Afton Day 和 Adam C Geisler 审阅。香港理工大学教授/博士 Grahame Bilbow, 清华大学外语系外籍专家 Shirley Howlett, Jessica Godfrey, Syau-Jyun Liang, Scott Andrickak, Andrew Leone 等对教材的编写方案、教学内容、编排体系等方面提出了许多宝贵建议,特此一并致谢。

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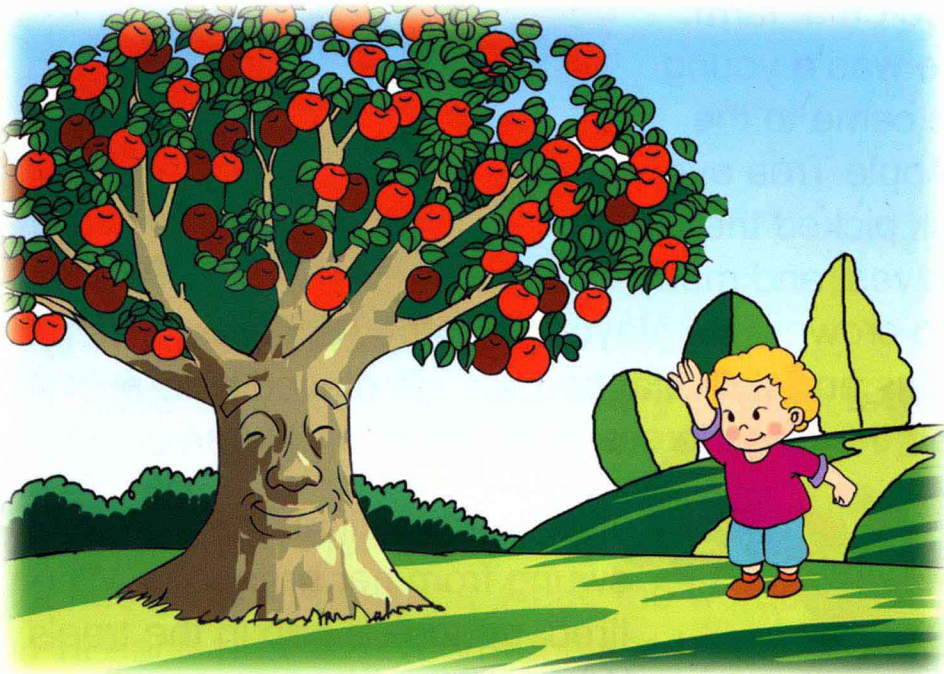

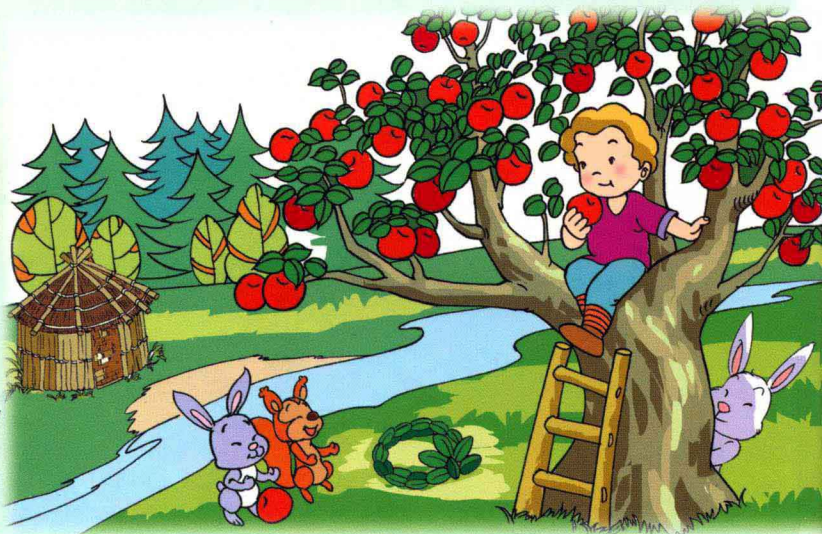

Once there was an apple tree in the forest. Its name was Giving Apple Tree.

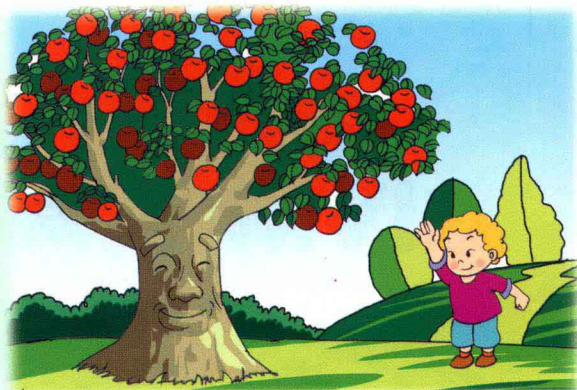
Jack lived on a farm. When he was a young child, he came to the Giving Apple Tree every day. Jack picked the tree's leaves, and made
