Nathan Hale was born in a small town in America, on June 6, 1755. After he graduated from a university in 1773, he became a school teacher. He joined the army after the war broke out. He was made captain at the beginning of 1776. After the British forces took Long Island, he was willing to go there to get maps of the British army's defence works. On September 21 of that year, he was caught by the British guards on his way back. He refused to give in. He was hanged the next morning. Just before he died he said that he only regretted that he had but one life to lose for his country. Young Hale was killed. He died a heroic death at the age of 21.
