总序

中学生学习英语的目的,是获得初步使用英语的能力,即能在口头上和书面上进行交际。培养这种能力的手段,仅仅进行知识的讲解是远远不够的。交际能力是在听、说、读、写的语言实践中练出来的。英语课是一门实践性很强的工具课。学英语的过程就是不断接触英语,反复使用英语的过程。

本丛书是专为高中学生进行语言训练而编写的。丛书共分四册,按阅读理解、短文改错、完形填空、单项填空四项内容各成一册。每册书所编练习均含三部分,即初级、中级和高级。初级适合高一使用,中级适合高二学生,针对会考要求,高级适合高三学生,面向高考。书后附全部练习答案。

本丛书在编写中遵循了三项原则:一是科学性,要求语言 地道、合乎规范;二是阶段性,循序渐进、满足不同层次学生的 需要;三是实用性,对教师和学生都适用。全部练习均经过教 学实践的检验,注重基础知识,基本技能的培养,同时又启发 思维,提高能力。

本书作者是全国重点中学——北京四中的高级教师李俊和、谢宇鸿、吕奇恩、毕勤、刘京等,他们具有多年的教学经验,并曾在美国进修学习。

分 册 前 言

本书为《高中英语阶梯训练丛书·短文改错》分册。全书共分三部分。第一部分为单句改错;第二部分为专题改错;第三部分为短文改错。第一部分以训练学生熟悉改错题型为主,按高考改错题型分为三类:(1)删除多余的词,(2)补全缺漏的词,(3)改正错误的词,每类各有50个单句。

第二部分根据教学大纲及《考纲说明》规定要求学生掌握的二十项主要语法专题,每个专题设有30个句子,要求学生辨别每句话中多余的词,缺少的词或用错的词,同时区别正确的句子。

第三部分按最新高考试题要求,每篇短文设有 10 个考查点,全面训练学生综合分析、判断的能力。共有 100 篇短文改错。

书后附有各部分改错试题答案,并标注如何进行改动的说明。

参加本书编写的还有刘一鸣、马同梅。
