中文版前言

器官移植经过漫长艰辛的发展,在20世纪成为了最伟大的医学成就。器官移植现已被公认为治疗多种终末期器官衰竭的最为有效地手段。但是,随着移植需求的增加,供器官的短缺已成为世界性难题。

为解决供器官的匮乏,活体器官移植诞生,并逐渐发展、成熟,由最初的活体肾移植,随后发展到活体肝移植、活体胰腺移植、活体小肠移植,现在多种活体器官移植已在世界范围内广泛开展。活体器官移植不仅缓解了供器官严重不足的困难,而且让许多亟待移植的危重患者及时得到供器官,接受移植,获得救治。相比尸体器官移植而言,活体器官移植因涉及不同的社会伦理学问题、健康供体的风险及处理、更为复杂的外科技术等,具有其较大的特殊性,移植医师也面临更大的挑战。

原著前言

传统医学概念中,医师仅为病患施行手术,而健康志愿者为挽救他人生命将自己置于手术风险之下的行为,赋予了活体器官移植特殊的含义。由于供/受者都接受手术,活体器官移植的潜在风险增加了一倍。有关活体器官移植的伦理、法律、医学、社会学以及心理学准则将随着活体移植的开展不断发展完善。本书中的观点仅代表目前我们对活体实体器官移植的认识。

目前距 Murray1954 年在波士顿成功施行的首例同卵双生子之间的活体肾移植已过去了半个多世纪。自那时起,活体肾移植相对于尸体肾移植的优势即已被广泛认同。因此,在 2002 年,美国的活体肾移植数量首次超过了尸体肾移植。大量文献业已证实相对于尸体肾移植,活体肾移植的优势不仅体现在受者和移植物存活率,也体现在术后免疫、感染并发症以及免疫抑制剂用量上。

20世纪90年代出现的活体肝移植大大降低了终末期肝病患者等待供肝期间的死亡率。而活体胰腺和小肠移植,虽然仍处于起步阶段,但数量也有了显著的增加。

本书是明尼苏达大学和伊利诺伊大学两个移植中心的合作成果。我们两个中心都已开展了所有腹部器官的活体移植项目,其中之一还进行了活体胰岛和活体肺移植的尝试。自2002年起,两个中心每隔两年组织一次国际性的腹部器官活体移植会议。已经举行的3次会议邀请到了来自亚洲,欧洲,北美的各领域权威参加。2004年及2006年会议的重要进展均已发表于本领域的重要期刊与大家分享。因此,我们两个中心决定编写此书对这一领域的进展进行一系统总结。

编者有幸邀请到了本领域的权威专家进行本书编写,手术部分的编者多是该领域的先驱。我们要感谢 Murray 分享其早期经验。感谢前器官共享网络(UNOS)主席 Francis Delmonico 在 2004 年和 2005 年组织的阿姆斯特丹以及温哥华会议,两个会议分别对活体肾供者与活体肝、胰腺、小肠、肺供者的相关问题进行了深入探讨。

本书针对的主要读者为移植外科医师和内科医师,也包括肾脏病学、肝脏病学、胃肠病学、内分泌学、病理学、免疫学领域的研究者。也可作为移植进修医师、住院医师、医学生、护理工作者、移植协调员的参考书。
