#### 前 言

为了配合高中英语教学,便于学生复习巩固所学语言知识并提高运用英语的能力,我们根据《全日制中学英语教学大纲》的基本要求,以全国现行统编教材为主要内容,采用客观性命题方式,编写了这套《高中英语单元练习手册》、《高中英语语法练习手册》共两册。

《高中英语语法练习手册》按语法项目分类编排。每个语法项目包括三个部分:第一部分为练习。这一部分多采用选择法填空的形式编辑而成。每个练习的选编,都经提炼与归纳,以能突出知识要点,解决易混易错的问题为目的。第二部分为练习答案。第三部分为注释。第一部分总要是对某些语言重点和难点进行语法阐述和对知识点归类总结,力求简明扼要的通俗易懂,即体现语法的系统性,又突出基础英语语法的重点。
