本书是根据许国璋主编的《英语》第一册至第四册内容编写的一套教学参考书。

本书于 1982 年以《英语教程初探》(上、中、下三册,与《英语》第二、三、四册内容相对应)为名出版以来,一直深受广大读者的欢迎。在当前改革开放的新形势下,为了满足更多读者学习《英语》的迫切需求,北京师范大学出版社决定聘请原书编写者对原版的三册书进行必要的修订和补充,并增编了第一册的相应内容,从而构成一套形式完整,内容翔实、由浅入深、简明实用的教学参考书。

在编写和修订过程中,本书的编写者始终坚持以多年教学的教案为基础,突出实用性为原则,并适当参阅有关参考资料,使这套书与《英语》教材环环紧扣,相得益彰。

这套书的一、二两册配合《英语》第一、二册内容,使 初学者通过大量的练习和反复实践,在语音、语法、词汇及 句子基本结构等方面打下坚实的基础。其中,第一册分两大部分,第一部分属语音阶段,根据《英语》第一册第一课至第十二课的内容综合编写为语音、语法、句型和课文四大项,并分别配以练习材料,为学生掌握基本技能技巧打下初步基础。从第一册的第二部分开始(包括第一册的第十三课至第廿四课和第二册全部),编写者针对各课的语言要点,逐段讲解注释,有选择地对一些惯用法作了对比说明,补充了大量例句,通过句型、问答、对话、听写、翻译等形式多样的练习提高学生运用语言的实际技能。为使学生系统掌握

英语语法基本知识,各课对相关的语法点均有详细的讲解和 专项练习,以增强学生使用语法的实践能力。此外,为了便 于学生更好地理解课文,编写者对课文的作者或背景材料作 了简要的介绍。

第三、四两册除根据课文需要有选择的保持以上内容外,更着重于句子结构练习和对句子或段落的释义。考虑到《英语》教材三、四册中语法部分主要是通过综合练习加以巩固,因此不再专项列出语法练习。

《英语》各册书上的全部练习(针对课文的问答题或口头练习除外)均在书后附有参考答案。这套参考书中补充的课文和语法等练习答案则分别附在各课之后。

这套参考书的特点是突出实践性,它不仅为教师提供了适于精讲多练的参考资料,对于广大自学者来说,它还是一套学好四册《英语》不可多得的辅导用书。

限于水平,加之修订和编写时间匆促,缺点和不足之处 在所难免,热切欢迎读者批评指正。
