

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前　　言

“美国之音”标准新闻是高校英语专业高年级听力教学中的一项重要内容。根据国家教委颁发的《高等学校英语专业高年级教学大纲》的精神、目标和要求，我们特编写了这本《美国之音标准英语新闻听力教程(第二辑)》，奉献给广大读者，以满足大家的需要。

本书在练习和题型的设计上，依据《大纲》的要求，尽量采用客观性题型：多项选择、正误判断和简单填充；与此同时，还设计了部分主观性题型：回答问题和摘要提要等，以培养学生综合归纳能力和分析推理能力。这样，既注意到了练习题型的灵活多样性，也避免了同类型题的单调性。在选材方面，为了增强语言的真实感，我们特意增加了几位国家元首的原声讲话和 VOA 驻各地记者发回的报道。

为帮助学生更好地听懂每条新闻，进一步扩大知识面，减少听的难度，我们在多数新闻前增加了一定份量的背景知识，供读者参阅。另外，还对一些生词作了英汉注释，以便于读者查阅。

本教材由三部分组成：WORKBOOK，KEY TO EXERCISES 和 TAPESCRIPIT。

本书中的新闻选自 1994 年 1 月至 1994 年 10 月期间 VOA 播放的标准新闻节目。本书配有录音带一盒。录音带音质清晰，语音标准。

本教材供高等学校英语专业三、四年级学生使用，同时也适合于同等水平的自学者使用，用以提高英语听力水平。

由于编者水平有限，加之背景知识资料缺乏，书中定有缺点和错误，恳请广大同仁、专家和读者指正。

William B. Clinton 克林顿

William B. Clinton, at the age of 46, was the youngest to be elected President of the United States since John F. Kennedy, who was elected president at the age of 43 in 1960. At the time of his election victory in 1992, he has already served for nearly 12 years as governor of Arkansas, his native state. With his rise to the presidency, he was the first generation born after World War II, the so-called baby boomer boomers, to achieve the country's highest office.

Cultural Notes

1. Seattle 西雅图

The port city of Seattle is the largest city and industrial center in the Pacific Northwest, with a population of about 600,000 and located in West-Central Washington. Ranking fifth in tonnage among the United States Pacific coast ports, Seattle is the closest port to the markets in Alaska and the Orient and serves as the trading center for the region.

As an industrial center, Seattle has large aircraft and ship

building plants, lumber and wood-working mills, and factories making aluminum, iron and steel products. The huge Boeing airplane plant employs over one-third of Seattle's industrial workers.

2. APEC (Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation) 亚太经济合作组织

APEC was founded in Singapore in 1989 with 17 member countries and regions including Australia, Brunei, Canada, China, Chinese Taipei, New Zealand, Indonesia, Japan, South Korea, Thailand, the United States, and Papua New Guinea. The organization aims to establish the Asia-Pacific Free Trade Area. APEC has been playing the leading role in the Asia-Pacific region.
