前言

《大学英语(文理科本科用)》试用教材是根据国家教育委员会审定批准的《大学英语教学大纲(文理科本科用)》编写的一套系列教材,分精读、泛读、听力、快速阅读、语法与练习五种教程。

本教材重视英语语言基础教学, 从各方面保证文、理科的通用性, 适用于综合大学、师范 院校和文科院校。

本教材的精读、泛读、快速阅读和听力教程各接分级教学的要求编写六册,每级一册, 语法与练习编写四册,供1—4级使用。精读与听力教程均配有教师用书和录音磁带。

上述五种教程根据各自的课型特点自成体系,但又相互配合,形成整体,以贯彻大纲所提出的三个层次的要求。"培养学生具有较强的阅读能力、一定的听的能力、初步的写和说的能力。"全套教材由复旦大学、北京大学、华东师范大学和中国人民大学合作编写,复旦大学董亚芬教授审订,同时还聘请两名专职外籍专家参加编写和文字审定工作。

《大学英语(文理科本科用)》听力教程由华东师范大学大学外语教学部负责编写。虞苏 美副教授和李慧琴副教授担任主编,杨霞华教授担任主审。

本书为听力教程第二册,供大学英语二级学生使用,参加编写工作的有关肇远、武凝秋、毛士国等同志。除主审外,还承澳籍专家 Jane Crawford 和 Elizabeth Craven协助审阅。

在本书编写的过程中,我校《英语听力入门》编写组为我们介绍了宝贵的经验;夏申同志也对编写原则提出了具体的意见和建议。上海曲艺剧团卞灵恩同志为本书配制了音乐。对 所有支持和帮助本书编写的人员和单位以及其他有关人士,我们特在此表示衷心的感谢。

使用说明

本教程按以下指导思想编写,

- 1. 根据大学英语教学课时少的特点,本教程着重进行听的基本技能训练。听力材料开始 阶段以日常生活题材为主,难度逐渐加深。题材逐渐多样。
- 2. 所选材料复盖大纲功能意念表所涉及的全部条目以及微技能表所规定的有关听的技能 和部分说的技能。
- 3.在培养学生听懂单词与句子的基础上,着重培养学生在语篇水平上的理解能力,以及对所听材料的分析、归纳、综合和推断的能力。
 - 4.为保证达到大纲规定的语速,平时训练用的材料语速略高于大纲所规定的指标。
 - 5. 教材内容力求新颖、多样和富于趣味性,语言力求真实。

本书为第二册,共二十课,供大学英语二级学生使用。结束时,有一次测试,每六课包括一单项听力技能训练,并附有小测验试题。每课使用时间为一节课,教师可视具体情况灵活掌握。

学生用书包括第一部分 (Part A) 的单项听力训练练习以及第二部分 (Part B) 的整体听力训练练习。在第二部分练习之前,列出了学习难点(Learning Points),包括生词、短语和句型。学生须对这部分进行预习。练习部分应在课内完成,不必事先准备。

练习完成后,学生可根据教师的讲解和评分标准,计算自己的成绩并纪录在后,供日后 进行自我评估。
