INTRODUCTION

Guizhou lies in the southeast of Southwest China. It borders Sichan Province on the north, Yunnan Province on the west, Guangxi Zhuang Autonomous Region on the south and Hunan Province on the east. The total area of Guizhou is 176,000 sq km, of which 92.5 percent is mountains and hilly lands. With 61.9 percent of the area being the Karst landform, it is one of the world's most typical areas with well developed Karst land formation.

Guizhou is one of the birthplaces of the paleohumankind in China. Several hundred thousand years ago, our ancestors began to work, live and multiply on the land. In 1413, it was first established as an administrative province of the Ming Dynasty.


Guizhou has a population of 35.088 million, of which 34.7 percent is ethnic minorities. There are 17 nationalities living here namely the Han, Miao, Buyi, Dong, Tujia, Yi, Gelao, Shui, Hui, Bai, Yao, Zhuang, Maonan, Mongol, Mulao, Man and Qiang. Under the administration of the provincial government are 2 cities, 4 prefectures and 3 ethnic autonomous prefectures. Under these prefectures are 86 counties and districts. The provincial capital city is Guiyang.


Guizhou enjoys a subtropical humidmonsoon cli-

mate. The annual average temperature is about 15°C and the annual frost free period is about 270 days. Guiyang, the provincial capital, is known as "the No.2" City of Spring" for its mild climate. Guizhou is one of the provinces (regions) abounding in natural resources in China. Of which, the energy, mineral, biological and tourist resources, take a lion's share in the country.


To accelerate its development and strengthen its economic capacity, Guizhou is promoting exploration by opening up and promoting development by exploration. By improving the quality of economic development and achieving better economic results, rapid economic development will be maintained. By 2000 the per capita GNP is expected to rise by 210 percent over that of 1980, and by 2010 the GNP will rise by 138 percent over that of 2000 to upgrade the comprehensive level of economic development.

In the coming 15 years, Guizhou will improve science and education with great vigor, strengthen the agricultural and infrastructural fundation, develop the energy, material, biological and tourist resources, and focus on the development of light industry, electronics and machinery industry, raw material industry and township enterprises.

Along with further opening up to the outside world, Guizhou has gradually formed a multi-level, multi-channel, multi-direction and all-round opening setup.
